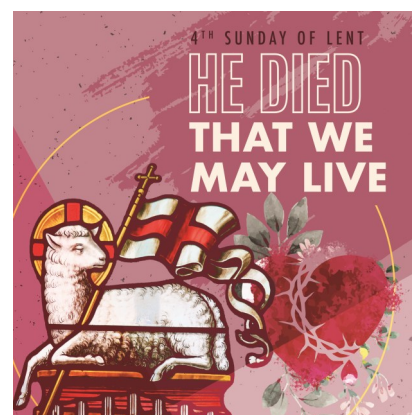

GOSPEL MEDITATION

4th SUNDAY OF LENT

A man looking a bit downtrodden approached me as I filled my car's gas tank. He asked, “May I share with you my testimony about how good God is?” “OK,” I skeptically answered. He went on to tell me that he had been an alcoholic and drug addict, and that God had healed him; now he was four years sober. He said, “I didn't deserve it, but now I'm a different person. God is so good! Have a terrific Tuesday!” A few minutes later, as I drove away, I saw him smiling and handing a homeless person some money. I was confronted with a choice: either he was a total fraud or God had changed him. *Something* had happened to him, and it didn't seem fake. Maybe it was God.

When Jesus heals the man born blind, the man becomes a challenge to everyone who meets him. They must decide. Is he the same blind person who they knew before? Who healed him and how? And what is the status of the one who can heal such infirmities? We shouldn't be surprised at the storm of doubt, hatred and animosity that swirls around the healed man — so it often goes when Jesus heals someone even to this day.

Like we often do, the religious leaders confronting the healed man declare that God is not at work. They ask with mocking superiority and dismissive disdain, “**You were born totally in sin, and are you trying to teach us?**” (John 9:34). And they cast him out. When Jesus clearly works in our lives, in us or around us, we should accept it, and give praise and thanks for this wonderful manifestation of his goodness.

Lenten challenge: Think of one way the Lord has healed you. Perhaps he healed a form of selfishness, a physical ailment, or something else. This week, find a person to whom you can share that testimony, and share it. Don't worry if they don't accept it was God who did it.

The Apology

I like to imagine the Prodigal Son practicing his apology in the mirror.

He wouldn't have, of course. Mirrors weren't exactly a dime a dozen back then. But I imagine him anyway, rehearsing the words as he contemplates his own gaunt reflection: “Father, I have sinned against God and against you. Treat me as you would treat one of your hired workers.”

In other words, I have done wrong. I deserve nothing from you. But please, don't let me starve. Save me.

The apology wasn't necessary to move the heart of the father. We know that because before they meet, before anything is said, the father is overcome with compassion — not because he got his satisfaction, that long-awaited “I'm sorry, I was wrong.” No, he's simply overjoyed to see his son alive. Even without apology, we know the father will beg his son to stay.

So why does the son apologize?

The father doesn't need the “I'm sorry.” He isn't starving and lost. He knew all along it was a bad idea. He doesn't need to learn any lessons.

But what a tragedy it would have been, if the son had never said he was sorry. Undoubtedly, his father would have let him stay as a hired worker, and he would have had food to eat. He would have survived. But he wouldn't have been what he was born to be.

I often think of the son's apology as I am kneeling in the confessional, awkwardly reciting sins God already knows and is eager to forgive. *Why are you doing this?* some people would ask. *God doesn't need this.*

It's the apology, you see. The apology means everything. The Prodigal Son was dead. The apology brought him back to life.

God doesn't need our repentance. *We need our repentance.*

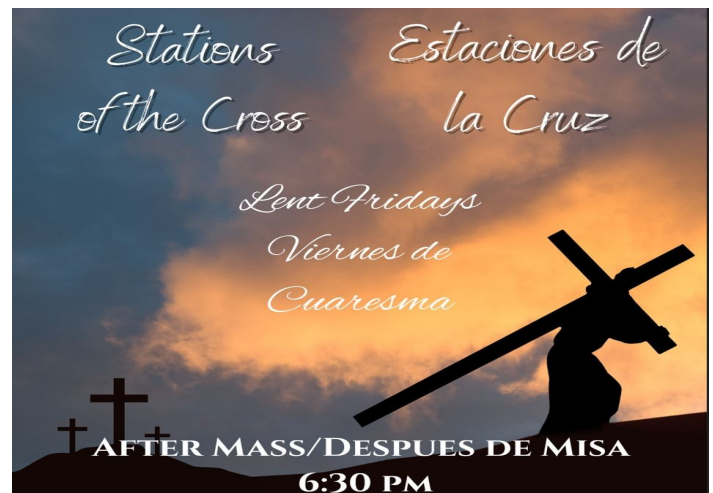

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

4º DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

Un hombre con aspecto algo desanimado se me acercó mientras llenaba el tanque de gasolina. Me preguntó: "¿Puedo compartir mi testimonio sobre lo bueno que es Dios?". "De acuerdo", respondí con escepticismo. Continuó contándome que había sido alcohólico y drogadicto, y que Dios lo había sanado; ahora llevaba cuatro años sobrio. Dijo: "No me lo merecía, pero ahora soy una persona diferente. ¡Dios es tan bueno! ¡Que tengas un excelente martes!". Unos minutos después, mientras me alejaba, lo vi sonriendo y dándole dinero a una persona sin hogar. Me enfrenté a una disyuntiva: o era un completo fraude o Dios lo había cambiado. Algo le había sucedido, y no parecía falso. Tal vez era Dios.

Cuando Jesús sana al hombre ciego de nacimiento, este se convierte en un desafío para todos los que lo conocen. Deben decidir. ¿Es el mismo ciego que conocieron antes? ¿Quién lo sanó y cómo? ¿Y cuál es la condición de quien puede sanar tales dolencias? No debería sorprendernos la tormenta de dudas, odio y animosidad que rodea al hombre sanado; así sucede a menudo cuando Jesús sana a alguien, incluso hoy en día.

Como solemos hacer, los líderes religiosos que confrontan al hombre sanado declaran que Dios no está obrando. Le preguntan con superioridad burlona y desdén desdeñoso: «Tú naciste completamente en pecado, ¿y tratas de darnos lecciones?» (Juan 9:34). Y lo expulsan. Cuando Jesús obra claramente en nuestras vidas, en nosotros o a nuestro alrededor, debemos aceptarlo y alabar y agradecer esta maravillosa manifestación de su bondad.

Desafío de Cuaresma: Piensa en una manera en que el Señor te ha sanado. Quizás sanó una forma de egoísmo, una dolencia física o algo más. Esta semana, busca a una persona con quien puedas compartir ese testimonio y compártelo. No te preocupes si no acepta que fue Dios quien lo hizo.

La Disculpa

Me gusta imaginar al Hijo Pródigo practicando su disculpa en el espejo.

No lo habría hecho, por supuesto. Los espejos no eran exactamente una moneda de diez centavos la docena en ese entonces. Pero me lo imagino de todos modos, ensayando las palabras mientras contempla su propia reflexión: "Padre, he pecado contra Dios y contra ti. Trátame como tratarías a uno de tus trabajadores contratados."

En otras palabras, he hecho mal. No merezco nada de ti. Pero por favor, no dejes que me muera de hambre. Sálvame.

La disculpa no era necesaria para conmover el corazón del padre. Lo sabemos porque antes de que se encuentren, antes de que se diga nada, el padre se siente abrumado por la compasión, no porque haya obtenido su satisfacción, ese tan esperado "Lo siento, me equivoqué." No, simplemente está muy contento de ver a su hijo con vida. Incluso sin disculpas, sabemos que el padre le rogará a su hijo que se quede.


Entonces, ¿por qué el hijo se disculpa?

El padre no necesita el "lo siento." No se está muriendo de hambre ni perdido. Siempre supo que era una mala idea. No necesita aprender ninguna lección.

Pero qué tragedia habría sido si el hijo nunca hubiera dicho que lo sentía. Sin duda, su padre le habría dejado quedarse como trabajador asalariado, y habría tenido comida para comer. Habría sobrevivido. Pero no habría sido lo que había nacido para ser.

A menudo pienso en la disculpa del hijo mientras estoy arrodillada en el confesionario, recitando torpemente pecados que Dios ya conoce y está ansioso por perdonar. ¿Por qué estás haciendo esto? Algunas personas preguntarían. Dios no necesita esto.

Es la disculpa, ¿ves? La disculpa lo es todo. El hijo prodigo había muerto. La disculpa lo devolvió a la vida. Dios no necesita nuestro arrepentimiento. Nosotros necesitamos nuestro arrepentimiento.

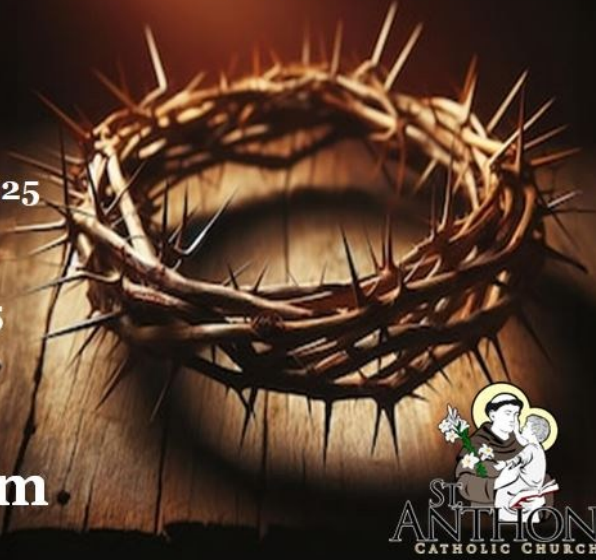

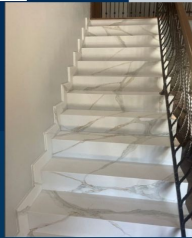
