

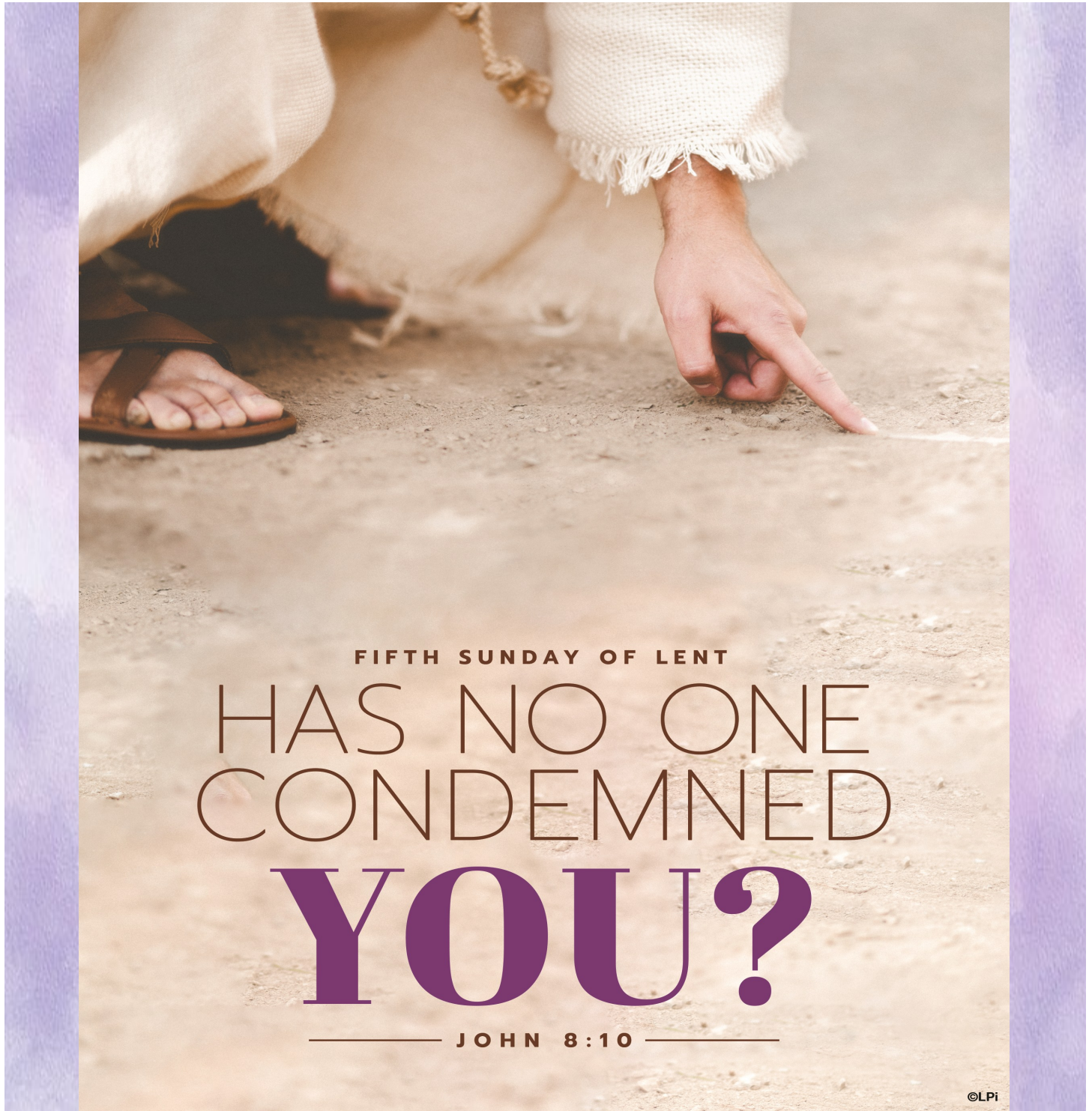

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

Thus says the LORD, who opens a way in the sea and a path in the mighty waters. (Is 43:16)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

5th SUNDAY OF LENT

"The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery and made her stand in the middle" (John 8:3). Why do they make her stand in the middle? Why not expose her on the periphery? The reason is something that affects us practically every day.

The center is what stabilizes a community's identity. We humans tend to center ourselves around an accused and condemned victim — though we rarely admit it. This renews our fragile communities and our power as those who weaponize the accusation. This is effective because it is often a victim who represents something truly dangerous for the group. In this case, adultery stands for the breakdown of a community and those within it, because it forces questions like: who is my father? Whose child is this? Is this child one of us, or that of an outsider? The accusers place the adulteress in the center because their community, like most, is built around turning an enemy into a victim.

Once you understand this, you'll see it almost anywhere humans group together (families, politics, workplaces, sports, schools, etc.). The good news is Jesus exposes this dynamic by deftly pointing out the sin-infected hearts of everyone besides the woman. They all leave, symbolizing the breakdown of the old order, and she is **"left alone before him."** A new community has begun, structured around the merciful love of Christ.

What is in your center? What is in the center of our parish and family communities? Strive to center on Christ's forgiveness, and we experience the new, lasting community we call the Church.

The Allure of Being Right

It wasn't a real question.

"The law of Moses says we should stone her. What do you say?" the Pharisees asked Jesus as they brought the adulterous woman before him. But they weren't *really* asking. They didn't care what Jesus' answer was. They didn't ask his opinion because they wanted to know. They asked because they wanted to use his words against him.

Righteousness, truth — that wasn't the goal. The goal was being right.

And in the middle of the whole scene, dragged before Jesus, used as a literal prop in this staged drama, is a woman. A real flesh-and-blood woman.

I find myself wanting to know more about her. She had been "caught in the act," they claimed, but I wonder what that even means. With whom was this act committed, and what were the reasons for her participation in it? Was she coerced? Was she scared? Was she confused? Was it really a cut-and-dry, black-and-white situation of adultery, of lust, of making the wrong decision?

We will never know the answers to these questions, and it doesn't matter — it's not our business. God knows the answers. God knows the truth of the matter: what she did, what she chose, what she felt. Because she wasn't a prop to Him. She was a person.

When God looks at us, he sees more than the worst decisions we've ever made.

I worry that we use one another as props even today, when we try like the Pharisees to illustrate "What is Right." We have a terrible tendency to see only decisions, and in doing so we dehumanize the people behind them.

Too often, we don't care about righteousness or truth. We just care about being right.

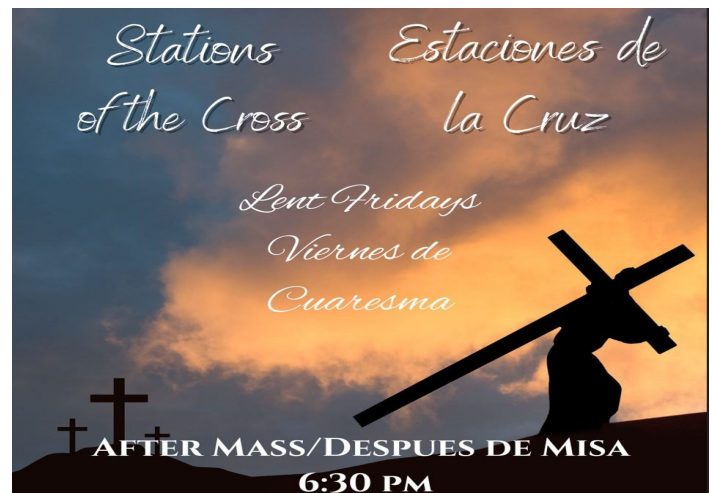

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

5º DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

“Los escribas y los fariseos trajeron a una mujer sorprendida en adulterio y la pusieron en medio” (Juan 8:3). ¿Por qué la ponen en medio? ¿Por qué no la exponen en la periferia? La razón es algo que nos afecta prácticamente a diario.

El centro es lo que estabiliza la identidad de una comunidad. Los humanos tendemos a centrarnos en una víctima acusada y condenada, aunque rara vez lo admitimos. Esto renueva nuestras frágiles comunidades y nuestro poder como quienes instrumentalizan la acusación. Esto es efectivo porque a menudo es la víctima quien representa algo verdaderamente peligroso para el grupo. En este caso, el adulterio representa la ruptura de una comunidad y de quienes la conforman, porque plantea preguntas como: ¿quién es mi padre? ¿De quién es este hijo? ¿Es este hijo uno de nosotros o de un extraño? Los acusadores colocan a la adúltera en el centro porque su comunidad, como la mayoría, se basa en convertir al enemigo en víctima.

Una vez que comprendas esto, lo verás casi en cualquier lugar donde se reúnan las personas (familias, política, lugares de trabajo, deportes, escuelas, etc.). La buena noticia es que Jesús expone esta dinámica al señalar con destreza los corazones contaminados por el pecado de todos, excepto de la mujer. Todos se van, simbolizando la ruptura del viejo orden, y ella queda **"sola ante él"**. Una nueva comunidad ha comenzado, estructurada en torno al amor misericordioso de Cristo.

¿Qué hay en tu centro? ¿Qué hay en el centro de nuestras comunidades parroquiales y familiares? Esforcémonos por centrarnos en el perdón de Cristo y experimentaremos la nueva y duradera comunidad que llamamos Iglesia.

CATOLICA - (PRACTICANTE) RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

La fascinación de tener la razón

No fue una verdadera pregunta.

“La ley de Moisés manda que la apedreemos. ¿Qué dices tú?”, preguntaron los fariseos a Jesús mientras le llevaban a la mujer adúltera a sus pies. Pero, ellos en realidad, no le estaban haciendo una pregunta a Jesús, ni les importaba cuál sería la respuesta de Jesús, no le preguntaron su opinión porque quisieran saber. Los fariseos le preguntaron pues querían usar las palabras de Jesús en su contra.

La justicia y la verdad no eran el propósito. Solamente querían dejar claro que ellos tenían razón. En medio de toda esta escena, arrastrada delante de Jesús, utilizada como una verdadera protagonista en este drama escenificado, está una mujer. Una mujer en verdad, de carne y hueso.

Me encuentro personalmente queriendo saber más acerca de ella. Los fariseos aseguraron que la “habían encontrado en el acto”, pero me pregunto qué significa eso. ¿Con quién se cometió este acto y los motivos por los cuales ella fue parte de eso? ¿Acaso la obligaron? ¿Tenía ella miedo? ¿Estaba confundida? ¿En realidad fue una situación a secas, claramente de adulterio, un acto de lujuria, de tomar la peor decisión?

Nunca sabremos las respuestas a esas preguntas, y no importa; no es asunto nuestro. Dios sabe las respuestas. Dios sabe la verdad de todo el asunto: lo que ella hizo, lo que decidió, qué sintió. Porque para Jesús, ella no era una actriz, sino que ella era una persona.

Cuando Dios nos ve, Él ve algo más allá de las peores decisiones que alguna vez hemos tomado. Me preocupa que nosotros nos usemos entre sí como protagonistas aún hoy en día, cuando intentamos, igual que los fariseos, demostrar “Lo que es correcto”. Tenemos una tendencia terrible a ver únicamente las decisiones, y al hacer eso deshumanizamos a las personas que toman esas decisiones.

Muy a menudo, no nos importa la justicia o la verdad. Solo queremos tener la razón.



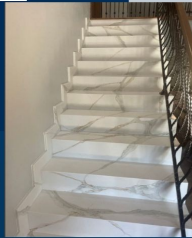
