SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame. (Is 50:7)

Psalm:

My God, my God, why have you abandoned me? (Ps 22)

Gospel:

Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." (Lk 22:19)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the lord

"As he rode along, the people were spreading their cloaks on the road." (Luke 19:36)

Consider how useless it is to spread your clothes on the ground for a donkey to walk on. The clothes get smeared with hooves, and who knows the grimy places where they've been? The animal may leave some unsavory presents on them. They may get stolen by a thief looking to make a buck. The thorns, thistles, rocks and muck of the road will leave stains. The clothes may never be useful again, and you'll probably walk home shivering without your normal covering. Yet this is precisely the gesture the people employ to welcome Jesus and his donkey. Why does this detail matter?

Wastefulness is an essential part of celebration. Consider the unnecessary extravagance of Christmas decorations, confetti and ticker tape parades, baseball players spraying each other with bottles of champagne after a victory, birthday gifts for kids and so on. This wastefulness signals celebration and therefore participation in higher identities (as believers, winners, and parents, to mention the above examples). That's what the wasted cloaks are all about. Those who donate their cloaks participate in Christ's kingship in Jerusalem — and we savor it two thousand years later.

The lesson? Learn how to "waste" money, time, clothes, and food on Christ. We do this at Mass, but in so many other ways, too, like serving the poor, going on retreats, and doing prayerful study. When we practice this holy wastefulness, Jesus will ride into our lives and we'll be more deeply members of his kingdom.

The Stones Will Cry Out

I have a complicated relationship with evangelization. I don't think that we (I'm talking about 21st-century American Catholics here) have had much formation around what exactly it means to proclaim the Gospel. We don't know how to do it. We don't really *want* to do it. It sounds kind of scary and awkward. It sounds like knocking on strangers' doors and yelling through the keyhole, "Have you accepted Christ as your Lord and Savior?" It sounds like arguing with friends and family. It sounds like a real pain.

I'm Catholic. I'm proud of being Catholic. I do my Catholic things in my Catholic house throughout my Catholic life. But is that enough?

All Christians are called to "wordless witness" in how they live their lives, writes Paul VI in the apostolic exhortation *Evangelii Nuntiandi* — but this alone, he says, is "insufficient." We must talk about Jesus. We must name him. We must speak of his life, his promises. We must *proclaim* him. We must be loud enough that a Pharisee would cringe at us. And yet — and Paul VI acknowledges this — it's not actually evangelization if we do it so badly that nobody listens. If we "impose" truth on someone's conscience instead of "proposing" it. If we make the mistake of thinking there is one singular way to share Christ with the great variety of personalities that exist in this world.

Dear reader, I am running out of column space, and still I have no answers for you, or for myself. I don't know how to do it well. But I know we have to try. We have to pray. We have to reflect. We have to be patient. We have to be humble. We have to remember it's about him and not about us.

Most of all, when we find ourselves confused and retreating into silence, we must remember Christ's words: "If they keep silent, the stones will cry out."

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera Lectura:

El Señor Dios es mi ayuda, por eso no he sido avergonzado; he puesto mi rostro como un pedernal, sabiendo que no seré avergonzado. (Is 50:7)

Salmo:

Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado? (Sal 22)

Segunda Lectura:

Por eso Dios lo exaltó sobremanera y le concedió el nombre que está sobre todo nombre. (Fil 2:9)

Evangelio:

Luego tomó el pan, pronunció la bendición, lo partió y se lo dio, diciendo: «Este es mi cuerpo, que será entregado por ustedes; hagan esto en memoria mía». (Lc 22:19)

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Domingo de Palmas de la Pasión del Señor

“Mientras él cabalgaba, la gente tendía sus mantos en el camino.” (Lucas 19:36)

Piensa en lo inútil que es extender la ropa en el suelo para que un burro la pise. La ropa se mancha con las pezuñas, y quién sabe en qué lugares sucios ha estado. El animal podría dejar algún regalo desagradable. Podría ser robada por un ladrón con ganas de lucrarse. Las espinas, los cardos, las piedras y el lodo del camino dejarán manchas. La ropa podría no volver a ser útil, y probablemente volverás a casa temblando sin tu abrigo habitual. Sin embargo, este es precisamente el gesto que la gente emplea para dar la bienvenida a Jesús y a su burro. ¿Por qué importa este detalle?

El derroche es parte esencial de la celebración. Piensa en la extravagancia innecesaria de las decoraciones navideñas, los desfiles con confeti y cintas de papel, los jugadores de béisbol rociándose con botellas de champán después de una victoria, los regalos de cumpleaños para los niños, etc. Este derroche indica celebración y, por lo tanto, participación en identidades superiores (como creyentes, ganadores y padres, por mencionar los ejemplos anteriores). De eso se tratan las capas desperdiciadas. Quienes donan sus capas participan en la realeza de Cristo en Jerusalén, y la disfrutamos dos mil años después.

¿La lección? Aprender a “desperdiciar” dinero, tiempo, ropa y comida en Cristo. Lo hacemos en la misa, pero también de muchas otras maneras, como sirviendo a los pobres, asistiendo a retiros y estudiando con oración. Cuando practicamos este santo derroche, Jesús entrará en nuestras vidas y seremos miembros más profundos de su reino.

CATOLICA - (PRACTICANTE) RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

Las piedras gritarán

Tengo una relación complicada con la evangelización. No creo que nosotros (y aquí me refiero a los católicos americanos del siglo XXI) hemos recibido suficiente formación acerca de lo que significa exactamente proclamar el Evangelio. No sabemos cómo hacerlo. En realidad, no *queremos* hacerlo. Eso suena aterrador e incómodo. Suena a ir a tocar la puerta de unos desconocidos y gritarles a través del hueco de la cerradura: “¿Han aceptado a Jesucristo como su Señor y Salvador?” Suena a discutir con los amigos y la familia. Suena como un verdadero dolor de cabeza.

Soy católico/a, estoy orgulloso de serlo, hago mis cosas católicas en mi hogar católico durante toda mi vida católica. Pero ¿es eso suficiente?

A todos los cristianos estamos llamados a ser “testigos silenciosos” en la manera en que vivimos nuestras vidas, escribe San Pablo VI en la exhortación apostólica *Evangelii Nuntiandi*; pero solo eso, dice él, es “insuficiente”. Tenemos que hablar acerca de Jesús, tenemos que pronunciar su nombre, tenemos que hablar de su vida, de sus promesas. Tenemos que *proclamarlo* a él. Tenemos que alzar la voz tan alto de modo que un fariseo retroceda ante nosotros. Y aun así – y San Pablo VI admite esto – en verdad no es evangelización si lo hacemos tan mal que nadie nos escucha. Si nosotros “imponemos” la verdad sobre la conciencia de alguien, en vez de “proponerla”; si cometemos el error de pensar que hay una forma única de compartir a Cristo ante la gran variedad de personalidades que existen en este mundo.

Queridos lectores, ya no me queda espacio en la columna, y todavía no tengo respuestas para ustedes, o para mí mismo. No sé cómo hacerlo bien, pero tenemos que intentarlo; tenemos que orar y reflexionar, ser pacientes, ser humildes. Tenemos que recordar que se trata de él y no de nosotros.

Sobre todo, cuando nos descubrimos confundidos y retrocedemos en el silencio, debemos recordar las palabras de Cristo: “si ellos callan, las piedras gritarán”.

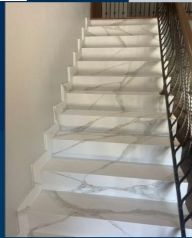
