



## SUNDAY'S READINGS

### First Reading:

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

When I was a young boy, my parents told me about their wedding. Then a few years later, they showed me my mother's wedding dress and my dad's suit. It was astonishing to see and touch garments that connected me to the event that led to my existence. Of course, I already believed they were married based on their word. But these holy garments made the event real and tangible for me.

Something like this is at play when St. John reports encountering in Jesus' tomb, "**the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place**" (John 20:7). Those two separate cloths, for his head and for his body respectively, meant a great deal to St. John and to the early Christians. Some years after the resurrection, there surfaced reports of two cloths with unusual characteristics, one bearing the image of a crucified man's body, another smaller one with the image of a wounded man's face. Some call them the Shroud of Turin and the Veil of Manoppello; they both can be seen today.

These two cloths have a long and complicated history, and scholars debate aspects of them. If you're curious, I encourage you to read about them. To be clear, I believe in the resurrection of Jesus because of the testimony of eyewitnesses and the gift of faith in the Church. Nevertheless, seeing these two mysterious cloths have made the life-giving event of Jesus' resurrection more real and tangible for me. Maybe they will for you, too. — *Father John Muir*

#### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS *By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman*

##### The Search

Everybody's trying to find God. They may not admit it. They may not even know it. They may talk around it, shy away from saying the name, both to others and to themselves: *God*. But I know for a fact that every person who was ever born into this world spent their lives searching for Him - somewhere, somehow, even if the only place they thought to look was in money or drugs.

It's a comforting fact, really — a reminder of how alike we all are. Catholic, Jewish, Muslim, atheist, rich, poor, Black, white. When it comes right down to it, the history of humanity is a never-ending Easter morning scene that plays in perpetuity. The sorrow, the shock, the confusion. Again and again, as each newborn baby opens his eyes, the search begins anew. *Where did he go? What has happened? Where can I find him?*

Catechesis isn't enough. Even those who learn about Jesus Christ, who accept his word, hang hesitantly outside the tomb, afraid to go in. Jesus' best friend — the disciple whom he loved — ran faster than Peter, so desperate he was to find his Lord. But when he got to the tomb and saw it empty, he got spooked. He froze.

Sometimes, we expect God to be right where we left Him — in a certain parish, with a certain priest, in a certain relationship, at a certain job. We show up, and we're heartbroken to see that our expectations have been turned upside down. *He's left us*, we think dejectedly, but we're wrong.

There is no one who has been abandoned by God. There are only those who stop looking for Him.

Don't let the empty tombs define you. It's the search that defines you.



# Oración Semanal, Adoración & Meditación

## LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

### Primera Lectura:

Pasó haciendo el bien y sanando a todos los oprimidos por el diablo, porque Dios estaba con él. (Hechos 10:38)

### Salmo:

Este es el día que hizo el Señor; alegrémonos y regocijémonos. (Salmo 118)

## MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

### Domingo de Pascua de la Resurrección del Señor

De niño, mis padres me contaron sobre su boda. Unos años después, me enseñaron el vestido de novia de mi madre y el traje de mi padre. Fue asombroso ver y tocar las prendas que me conectaron con el acontecimiento que dio origen a mi existencia. Claro que ya creía que se habían casado por su palabra. Pero estas vestiduras sagradas hicieron que el acontecimiento fuera real y tangible para mí.

Algo así se refleja cuando San Juan relata haber encontrado en la tumba de Jesús «el sudario que había cubierto su cabeza, no con las vendas, sino enrollado en un lugar aparte» (Juan 20:7). Esos dos sudarios, para la cabeza y para el cuerpo respectivamente, significaron mucho para San Juan y para los primeros cristianos. Años después de la resurrección, surgieron noticias de dos sudarios con características inusuales: uno con la imagen del cuerpo de un hombre crucificado y otro, más pequeño, con la imagen del rostro de un hombre herido. Algunos los llaman el Sudario de Turín y el Velo de Manoppello; Ambos se pueden ver hoy en día.

Estos dos lienzos tienen una historia larga y compleja, y los estudiosos debaten algunos aspectos de ellos. Si siente curiosidad, le animo a leer sobre ellos. Para ser claro, creo en la resurrección de Jesús gracias al testimonio de testigos oculares y al don de la fe en la Iglesia. Sin embargo, ver estos dos misteriosos lienzos ha hecho que el acontecimiento vivificante de la resurrección de Jesús sea más real y tangible para mí. Quizás también lo sea para usted.

## CATOLICA - (PRACTICANTE) RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

### La búsqueda

Todos están intentando encontrar a Dios. Tal vez no lo admitan, ni siquiera lo sepan. Quizá hablen de ello o evitan decir el nombre, a otros y a ellos mismos: *Dios*. Pero estoy seguro que todas las personas nacidas en este mundo pasaron sus vidas buscándolo — en algún lugar, de alguna manera, aunque el único lugar donde pensaron buscar fue en el dinero o en las drogas.

Es un hecho reconfortante, en verdad: un recordatorio de cuanto nos parecemos todos nosotros, católicos, judíos, musulmanes, ateos, ricos, pobres, negros o blancos. Si lo analizamos bien, la historia de la humanidad es una escena de mañana de Pascua que nunca cesa de repetirse. El dolor, el impacto, la confusión, una y otra vez, tan pronto cada niño recién nacido abre sus ojos, comienza la búsqueda de nuevo. *¿A dónde se fue? ¿Qué pasó? ¿Dónde lo encuentro?*

No es suficiente la catequesis. Aún aquellos que aprenden sobre Jesucristo, los que aceptan su palabra, se mantienen vacilantes afuera del sepulcro, temerosos de entrar. El mejor amigo de Jesús, el discípulo amado, corrió más rápido que Pedro; estaba tan desesperado por encontrar a su Señor. Sin embargo, cuando llegó al sepulcro y lo vio vacío, se espantó, se quedó paralizado.

Algunas veces, esperamos que Dios esté justo allí donde lo dejamos — en cierta parroquia, con un cierto sacerdote, en una cierta relación, en un cierto trabajo. Llegamos y se nos rompe el corazón al ver que nuestras expectativas han sido puestas de cabeza. *Dios nos ha dejado* — pensamos, muy decepcionados — *pero nos equivocamos*.

Dios no ha abandonado a nadie. Solo están aquellos que dejaron de buscarlo.

No permitas que los sepulcros vacíos te definan. Es la búsqueda lo que te define.
