GOSPEL MEDITATION

Sixth Sunday of Easter

Jonathan Haidt's 2024 book entitled "The Anxious Generation" argues that today's kids are marked by significant increases in anxiety, as the title suggests. Smartphones, social media, economic uncertainty, the chaos of a global pandemic, fear regarding climate change, and the so-called "meaning crisis" all contribute to strikingly high levels of anxiety in young people today. I'm a bit older than this generation, but I feel it, too. The world can be too much to handle.

The Gospel this week offers a stunning solution for troubled souls. To his overwhelmed and anxious disciples, the risen Jesus says, "**Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you**" (John 14:27). His peace is that of the one who was overwhelmed on the cross and then conquered death by the power of his divinity, his bond of love with the Father. He offers us this unshakeable peace.

Of course, mental illness does not magically disappear because of the risen Jesus. But he does walk with us and offer us his peace in the midst of our suffering. The peace the world gives is not like his because it is weak, uncertain, and self-generated. Jesus' peace is strong, sure, and given as a gift from God. He gives it to us amid our anxiety. Will you receive it as a gift? I hope so. He wants to fill the hearts of this generation with his peace.

My Peace I Give to You

When John has a vision of heavenly Jerusalem, he sees walls.

"A massive, high wall," to be more precise. In the modern lexicon, walls have a negative connotation; we use them as metaphors for all that is exclusionary and rigid. But throughout much of history, walls have meant something very different. In the ancient world, walls meant safety.

Walls meant peace.

"My peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you," Jesus tells his disciples in today's Gospel. "Not as the world gives do I give it to you."

So what's the difference between the peace we know in the world, and the peace we know in Christ?

Well, I would argue that the difference is that the peace we know in Christ *exists*. We know no real peace in this world. Sometimes, we witness a sort of mirage of peace — something *like* it, but just a little off, and always on the horizon, never within reach.

Peace, to me, means rest. It means quiet. It means the absence of confrontation, of conflict, of anxiety. But I can't actually experience any of that in this life, not in a substantial way. I can rest — but I never really feel rested. I can retreat to a room by myself to have silence, but someone always knocks on the door, and even if they don't, my thoughts get pretty loud.

And boy oh boy, are those thoughts full of confrontation. Full of anxiety, full of conflict. Wherever I go to find peace, the world finds *me* and banishes it.

I think of the walls of heavenly Jerusalem, so high and so sturdy, guarded so scrupulously by God's strongest angels. These walls are not barriers. They are shields. They are arms, encircling us, gathering us in.

In Christ alone can we find peace in this world.

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Sexto Domingo de Pascua

El libro de Jonathan Haidt, publicado en 2024 y titulado "La Generación Ansiosa", argumenta que los jóvenes de hoy se caracterizan por un aumento significativo de la ansiedad, como sugiere el título. Los teléfonos inteligentes, las redes sociales, la incertidumbre económica, el caos de una pandemia mundial, el miedo al cambio climático y la llamada "crisis de sentido" contribuyen a niveles sorprendentemente altos de ansiedad en los jóvenes de hoy. Soy un poco mayor que esta generación, pero también lo siento. El mundo puede ser demasiado para soportarlo.

El Evangelio de esta semana ofrece una solución conmovedora para las almas atribuladas. A sus discípulos abrumados y ansiosos, Jesús resucitado les dice: "La paz les dejo; mi paz les doy" (Juan 14:27). Su paz es la de quien fue abrumado en la cruz y luego venció a la muerte por el poder de su divinidad, su vínculo de amor con el Padre. Él nos ofrece esta paz inquebrantable.

Por supuesto, las enfermedades mentales no desaparecen mágicamente gracias a Jesús resucitado. Pero él camina con nosotros y nos ofrece su paz en medio de nuestro sufrimiento. La paz que da el mundo no es como la suya porque es débil, incierta y autogenerada. La paz de Jesús es fuerte, segura y un regalo de Dios. Nos la da en medio de nuestra ansiedad. ¿La recibirás como regalo? Espero que sí. Él quiere llenar los corazones de esta generación con su paz.

CATOLICA - (PRACTICANTE) RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

Mi paz les dejo, mi paz les doy

Cuando Juan tiene la visión de la Jerusalén celestial, él mira los muros.

“Un muro alto y enorme”, para ser más preciso. En el léxico moderno, los muros tienen una connotación negativa; los usamos como metáforas de todo lo excluyente y rígido. Sin embargo, a lo largo de gran parte de la historia, los muros han significado algo muy diferente. En el mundo antiguo, los muros significaban seguridad.

Los muros significan la paz.

“Mi paz les dejo, mi paz les doy”, dice Jesús a sus discípulos en el evangelio de hoy. “Yo no doy la paz, como el mundo la da.”

Entonces, ¿cuál es la diferencia entre la paz que conocemos en el mundo y la paz que conocemos de Cristo?

Bueno, yo argumentaría que la diferencia es que la paz que conocemos en Cristo *existe*. Nosotros no conocemos una paz real en este mundo. A veces, somos testigos de una especie de espejismo de paz; algo *parecido*, pero un poco lejano y siempre en el horizonte, nunca alcanzable.

La paz, para mí significa descanso. Significa silencio. Significa ausencia de confrontación, de conflicto y de ansiedad. Pero en realidad no puedo experimentar nada de eso en esta vida, no de forma sustancial. Puedo descansar, pero nunca me siento descansado. Puedo retirarme a una habitación a solas para tener silencio, pero siempre alguien toca a la puerta. E incluso, si no lo hacen, mis pensamientos se vuelven bastantes ruidosos.

Y, vaya, esos pensamientos están llenos de confrontación. Llenos de ansiedad, llenos de conflictos. Dondequiera que vaya en busca de paz, el mundo *me* encuentra y la destruye.

Pienso en los muros de la Jerusalén celestial, tan altos y tan resistentes, custodiados tan minuciosamente por los ángeles más fuertes de Dios. Estos muros no son barreras; son escudos. Son los brazos que nos rodean, que nos reúnen.

Solo en Cristo podemos encontrar la paz en este mundo.

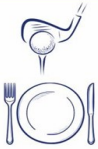

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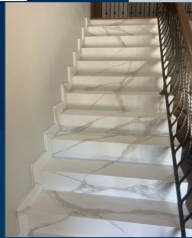
