

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

THE DESTINY OF ALL MORTAL FLESH

The celebration of today's feast on a Sunday is unusual on our Roman Catholic calendar. Our observance of the Lord's Day is held in such high esteem that few other feasts replace it. Occasionally there is a feast—usually of one of the saints—in which the saving power of God in Christ is so uniquely focused that the Roman rite deems it worthy of celebration on the Lord's Day. Today is such a feast. Yet some are surprised at the brevity of the dogma in its entirety: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The Roman Catholic Church never defined any specifics or particulars about the event itself. It is not in the scriptures. There are no verifiable eyewitness accounts. At its core, the dogma reveals in Mary the destiny of all mortal flesh, and reinforces our creedal belief in resurrection of the body. This feast strengthens our faith, defined last week in Hebrews as the realization of things hoped for. We find, in Mary, that realization of what we all hope for, what Paul today affirms: "In Christ shall all be brought to life" (1 Corinthians 15:22).

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Today we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The readings give us much to ponder as we reflect on Mary, her special place prepared by God for eternity, and all that resulted from her “yes” to the angel’s message that she was to bear the Christ, the anointed one of God. Mary is “blessed among women,” the vessel for the life and salvation of Christ for all generations. Mary always points us to her son, Jesus. Through her witness, we are inspired to proclaim the greatness of the Lord with our lives. In her Assumption, we are assured that Mary is in the presence of God, pointing the way to all who live as God’s good and holy people in this life while we await ultimate fulfillment in the next.

BLESSED ARE YOU

Elizabeth had waited a long time for the child she carried. She was beyond child-bearing age by the time she conceived the baby who would be known as John the Baptist. We can only imagine her joy and amazement when the baby leaped in her womb at Mary’s arrival. Elizabeth was old and Mary young, yet both trusted in the goodness of the Lord; both relied on the Holy Spirit to be with them in the perplexing, exciting, and anxious time in which they found themselves. They show us what it means to put God at the center of our lives. Their story may inspire us to believe that God’s loving mercy awaits in every moment of our lives. Elizabeth calls Mary and the child in her womb “blessed,” holy. Mary’s holiness is found in her belief in God and her willingness to carry out God’s plan by carrying the child Jesus in her womb. How are you called to holiness? In what ways are you willing to carry out God’s plan?

MY SOUL PROCLAIMS

Mary’s response to Elizabeth, which we hear in today’s Gospel, is known as the Magnificat. Mary “magnifies” the greatness of the Lord—through her, we see God’s mercy clearly. Mary’s canticle is a declaration that God cares for the lowly and vulnerable, for the humble and hungry. This, Mary says, is the God for whom the people of Israel had long waited. This is God in whom we believe. Like Mary, the Almighty has done great things for us. As followers of Mary’s son, Jesus Christ, we are called to make this merciful, caring God known to those who are in need. How will you glorify, magnify, the Lord by your life?

On Saturday, 21 August 2021 at the 5PM Vigil Mass, His Excellency Most Reverend Bishop Michael Barber will administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our Youth Confirmandi. Expect that this Mass will be crowded with 70 Confirmandi, their Sponsors, family, and friends. These Confirmandi have been diligently studying for the past two years to reach this milestone. With this Sacrament they will become fully initiated Catholics. Congratulations to all!

Restoration of the Obligation to Attend Mass

The lifting of the dispensation from the Sunday Mass Obligation will come into force on Sunday, August 15th, the Solemnity of the Assumption. Due to the surge with the Delta variant we will continue outdoor Masses, livestream and distribution of Holy Communion outside of Mass.

La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María

EL DESTINO DE TODA CARNE MORTAL

La celebración de la fiesta de hoy en domingo es inusual en nuestro calendario católico. Nuestra observancia del Día del Señor es de tan alta estima que pocas otras fiestas la reemplazan. Ocasionalmente hay una fiesta –usualmente de uno de los santos– en que el poder salvador de Dios en Cristo está tan singularmente manifiesto que el rito romano la considera digna de celebrarse en el Día del Señor. Hoy es tal fiesta. Sin embargo, algunos se sorprenden por la brevedad del dogma en su totalidad: Pronunciamos, declaramos y definimos ser dogma de revelación divina que la inmaculada madre de Dios, siempre Virgen María, cumplido el curso de su vida fue asunta en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celeste". La Iglesia Católica nunca definió nada específico ni los particulares sobre el hecho. No existen relatos verificables de testigos. En su esencia, el dogma revela en María el destino de toda carne mortal, y refuerza nuestro credo y fe en la resurrección del cuerpo. Esta fiesta fortalece nuestra fe, definida la semana pasada en la carta a los hebreos como la realización de aquello que esperamos. Encontramos en María la realización de lo que todos esperamos, y que Pablo afirma hoy: "en Cristo todos volverán a la vida" (1 Corintios 15:22).

Las lecturas nos dan mucho que pensar al reflexionar sobre María, su lugar especial preparado por Dios para la eternidad, y todo lo que resultó de su “sí” al mensaje del ángel de que iba a dar a luz al Cristo, el ungido de Dios. María es “bendita entre las mujeres”, el vientre para la vida y la salvación de Cristo para todas las generaciones. María siempre nos señala a su hijo Jesús. A través de su testimonio, nos inspira a proclamar la grandeza del Señor con nuestra vida. En su Asunción, se nos asegura que María está en la presencia de Dios, señalando el camino a todos los que viven como pueblo bueno y santo de Dios en esta vida, mientras esperamos la plenitud definitiva en la próxima vida.

BENDITA ERES

Isabel había esperado mucho tiempo al bebé que llevaba en su seno. Ella ya no estaba en edad de poder engendrar hijos cuando concibió al niño que sería conocido como Juan el Bautista. Sólo Podemos imaginar su alegría y asombro cuando el bebé saltó en su vientre ante la llegada de María. MI ALMA PROCLAMA

La respuesta de María a Isabel, que escuchamos en el Evangelio de hoy, se conoce como el Magnificat. María “magnifica” la grandeza del Señor: a través de ella, vemos claramente la misericordia de Dios. 
