SUNDAY'S READINGS

GOSPEL MEDITATION

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 13:22-30

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun.

When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "**Strive to enter through the narrow gate**" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"

Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; *hypomone* in Greek). Strive! Endure! Keep going! The one absolutely necessary virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey. The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS *By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman*

Heaven and Regina George

There are certain phrases that serve as a kind of shibboleth for millennials, a dog whistle that only ears formed between 1981 and 1996 can discern. "You can't sit with us!" is one of those phrases.

It's from the movie *Mean Girls*, (which, I hear from my younger family members, has now become cool with the kids again, so maybe my point about it being niche is incorrect). The character Regina George, merciless ruler of the cool kids, is rejected from the ultra-exclusive lunch table she herself formed when her minions, tired of her cruelty, serve her the most devastating words a teenager can hear in public: "You can't sit with us."

So passes earthly glory, as they say.

At first blush, this Gospel gives "Mean Girls" vibes. We have an image of the unlucky masses clamoring for entry into the kingdom of heaven as God locks the door against them, saying, "I do not know where you are from."

Very "you-can't-sit-with-us."

But we need to remember that the people pounding on the door of heaven in today's Gospel aren't people who wanted a seat at God's lunch table — at least, not until it was the only lunch table left, because they had Regina George'd their way out of all the other ones.

Jesus' whole thing was that you *can* sit with us, whoever you are, wherever you're from and whatever you've done. But there are a lot of lunch tables in the world, and not everyone wants to be at one with rules like "repent" and "be good to that person you really don't like." It's not always an easy table to sit at, especially when there are so many other options.

We have to choose heaven before heaven becomes our only choice.

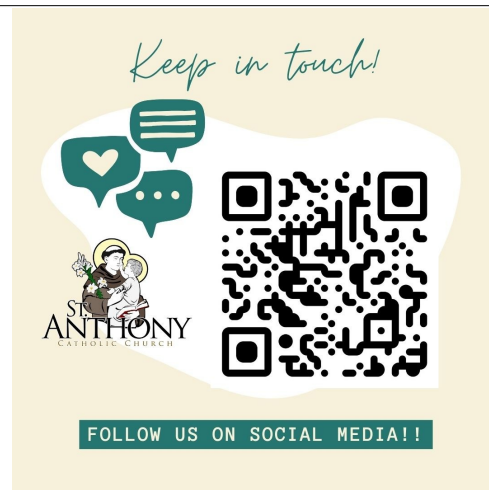

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera Lectura:

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

21^{er} Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 13:22-30

Llevo casi toda mi vida escalando la montaña Camelback en Phoenix, Arizona. Son cuarenta y cinco minutos intensos hasta la cima. Cerca de la cima, el final parece de repente mucho más lejano y empinado. En ese momento, un excursionista que baja suele animar: "¡Sigue! La cima está ahí mismo. No es tan lejos como parece. ¡Tú puedes!". Suele funcionar. Tras otros cinco minutos de esfuerzo, llegas a la cima y disfrutas de un glorioso panorama del desierto de Sonora en el Valle del Sol.

Cuando le preguntan a Jesús cuántas personas se salvan, responde: "Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta estrecha" (Lucas 13:24). ¿Cuántas? ¡Esfuércense! Concéntrense en su camino. ¿Qué tiene que ver el censo celestial con ustedes o conmigo? ¿Cómo ayudaría a un excursionista en una montaña preguntar a los que bajan: "¿Cuántas personas llegarán a la cima?" Una respuesta normal sería algo como: "¿Por qué es relevante esa pregunta? ¡Sigue adelante!".

Jesús vincula una virtud directamente con la salvación: la perseverancia (cf. Mt 24,13; hypomone en griego). ¡Esfuézate! ¡Persevera! ¡Sigue adelante! La única virtud absolutamente necesaria es la perseverancia: no rendirnos en nuestro camino. La montaña que nos cuesta escalar a menudo son nuestras propias debilidades, fracasos y pecados. Persevera en la oración. Sigue celebrando los sacramentos. Acepta tus obligaciones diarias. Con la gracia de Dios, eres lo suficientemente fuerte para seguir adelante. Quizás la cima no esté tan lejos como temes. ¡Sigue adelante!

El Cielo y Regina George

Hay ciertas frases que sirven como una especie de contraseña para los Millennials, un silbato para perros que solo los oídos formados entre 1981 y 1996 pueden discernir. "¡No puedes sentarte con nosotros!" es una de esas frases.

Es de la película *Chicas Pesadas*, (que, según escuché de mis familiares más jóvenes, ahora se ha vuelto genial con los niños nuevamente, así que tal vez mi punto sobre que es de nicho sea incorrecto). El personaje de Regina George, gobernante despiadada de los chicos "cool," es rechazada de la mesa de almuerzo ultra exclusiva que ella misma formó cuando sus secuaces, cansados de su crueldad, le sirven las palabras más devastadoras que un adolescente puede escuchar en público: "No puedes sentarte con nosotros". Así pasa la gloria terrenal, como dicen.

A primera vista, este Evangelio da vibras de "Chicas Pesadas". Tenemos una imagen de las masas desafortunadas clamando por entrar en el reino de los cielos mientras Dios les cierra la puerta, diciendo: "No sé de dónde son".

Muy "no-puedes-sentarte-con-nosotros".

Pero debemos recordar que las personas que golpean la puerta del cielo en el Evangelio de hoy no son personas que querían un asiento en la mesa del almuerzo de Dios, al menos, no hasta que fuera la única mesa de almuerzo que quedaba, porque habían sido echados de todas las demás.

Todo Jesús decía *puedes* sentarte con nosotros, seas quien seas, seas de donde seas y hayas hecho lo que hayas hecho. Pero hay muchas mesas de almuerzo en el mundo, y no todos quieren estar de acuerdo con reglas como "arrepíentete" y "sé bueno con esa persona que realmente no te cae bien". No siempre es una mesa fácil en donde sentarse, especialmente cuando hay tantas otras opciones.

Tenemos que elegir el cielo antes de que el cielo se convierta en nuestra única opción.

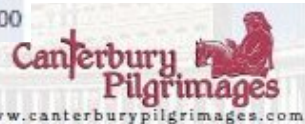
