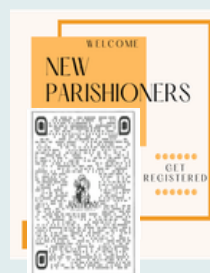

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

I will place the key of the House of David on Eliakim's shoulder; when he opens, no one shall shut, when he shuts, no one shall open. (Is 22:22)

Psalm:

Lord, your love is eternal; do not forsake the work of your hands. (Ps 138)

Second Reading:

For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen. (Rom 11:36)

Gospel:

"I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Mt 16:19)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Matthew 16:13-20

The question Jesus asked his disciples was: "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" The answer came quickly; they replied eagerly: "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, or Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." Immediately, another question followed: "And you, who do you say I am?" (Matthew 16:13-17). This second question is directed personally at the disciples: who is Jesus to each of them? Peter identifies Him clearly: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16). Jesus tells him that this revelation comes from the Father in heaven, not from his own human capacity.

Revelation and deep faith are required to identify Jesus Christ as our Messiah and Savior. How is your personal relationship with Jesus? What do your family, friends, and community say about Him? The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in number 424, tells us: "Moved by the grace of the Holy Spirit and drawn by the Father, we believe in Jesus and confess: 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God' (Mt 16:16). On the rock of this faith confessed by St. Peter, Christ has built his Church." In his Gospel, Matthew shows us a special bond with the Church, and we must pay attention to it. The identity of Jesus with the ecclesial community is unique. So, the question arises: what is the Church to me? Do I see a living relationship between Jesus and the Church? Let us pray for the Church and for Pope Leo XIV, especially today.

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Only Peter Has the Answer

"What do you think of the Pope?"

After the election of Pope Leo XIV in 2025, all my non-Catholic friends texted me this question. The result of the papal conclave was dominating the news cycle, and everyone was curious about this man who would now be so prominent on the world stage, making me temporarily popular with people who apparently need more (and better) Catholics in their lives.

In today's Gospel, we see Jesus entrust Peter and his heirs with the stewardship of the kingdom here on earth, creating an unbroken line of authority which stretches through the millennia all the way to our current Pope — whoever he is at the time you are reading this.

I don't know if you like the Pope. The same goes for your local bishop and your pastor. If a friend texted you, "What do you think of him?" I have no idea how you would respond.

All I know is this: it doesn't really matter. What really matters is what we would say if a friend texted us the same question about Jesus Christ: "What do you think of him, and why?"

In today's Gospel, Jesus doesn't ask his disciples to take an IQ test. He doesn't try to find out which one is the nicest, the hardest worker, the most humble, or even the holiest.

He asks a very simple question: "Who do you say that I am?"

Peter has the answer.

I am not Catholic because I like the Pope. I am not Catholic because the human representatives of the Church have anything to offer me (they often do, but this is beside the point).

I am Catholic because only Peter has the answer.

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera lectura:

Pondré la llave de la casa de David sobre el hombro de Eliaquim; cuando él abra, nadie cerrará; cuando él cierre, nadie abrirá. (Is 22, 22)

Salmo:

Señor, tu amor es eterno; no abandones la obra de tus manos. (Sal 138)

Segunda lectura:

Porque de él, por él y para él son todas las cosas. A él la gloria por siempre. Amén. (Rom 11, 36)

Evangelio:

«Te daré las llaves del reino de los cielos. Todo lo que ates en la tierra quedará atado en el cielo; y todo lo que desates en la tierra quedará desatado en el cielo». (Mt 16, 19)

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Mateo 16:13-20

La pregunta que Jesús hizo a sus discípulos fue: “Según el parecer de la gente, ¿quién es este Hijo del Hombre?”. La respuesta no se hizo esperar; presurosos respondieron: “unos dicen que Juan el Bautista, otros que Elías, o Jeremías, o alguno de los profetas”. Enseguida vino otra pregunta: “Y ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo?” (Mateo 16:13-17). Esta segunda pregunta ya es directa para los discípulos: quién es Jesús para cada uno de ellos. Pedro lo identifica con claridad: “Tú eres el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios vivo” (Mateo 16:16). Jesús le dice que esta revelación viene del Padre que está en los cielos y no de su propia capacidad humana.

Se necesita revelación y una fe profunda para identificar a Jesucristo como nuestro Mesías y Salvador. ¿Cómo anda tu relación personal con Jesús? ¿Qué dicen tu familia, tus amigos y tu comunidad acerca de Él? El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en el número 424, nos dice: “Movidos por la gracia del Espíritu Santo y atraídos por el Padre, nosotros creemos y confesamos a propósito de Jesús: ‘Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios vivo’ (Mt 16:16). Sobre la roca de esta fe, confesada por san Pedro, Cristo ha construido su Iglesia”. Mateo, en su Evangelio, nos muestra un vínculo especial con la Iglesia, y debemos prestar atención a ello. La identidad de Jesús con la comunidad eclesial es única. Entonces, ahora vale la pregunta: ¿qué es la Iglesia para mí? ¿Veo una relación viva entre Jesús y la Iglesia? Pidamos por la Iglesia y oremos por el Papa León XIV, especialmente hoy.

Solo Pedro tiene la Respuesta

"¿Qué opinas del Papa?"

Tras la elección del Papa León XIV en 2025, todos mis amigos no católicos me enviaron esta pregunta por mensaje. El resultado del cónclave papal dominaba el ciclo informativo, y todos sentían curiosidad por este hombre que ahora sería tan prominente en el escenario mundial, haciéndome temporalmente popular entre personas que aparentemente necesitan más (y mejores) católicos en sus vidas.

En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos a Jesús confiar a Pedro y a sus herederos la administración del reino aquí en la tierra, creando una línea de autoridad ininterrumpida que se extiende a lo largo de los milenios hasta nuestro Papa actual — quienquiera que sea en el momento en que estés leyendo esto.

No sé si te gusta el Papa. Lo mismo ocurre con tu obispo local y tu párroco. Si un amigo te escribiera: "¿Qué te parece él?" No tengo ni idea de cómo responderías.

Lo único que sé es esto: realmente no importa. Lo que realmente importa es lo que diríamos si un amigo nos enviara un mensaje con la misma pregunta sobre Jesucristo: "¿Qué piensas de él y por qué?"

En el Evangelio actual, Jesús no pide a sus discípulos que hagan una prueba de Coeficiente Intelectual (CI). No intenta averiguar cuál es el más amable, el más trabajador, el más humilde o incluso el más santo.

Hace una pregunta muy sencilla: "¿Quién dices que soy?"

Pedro tiene la respuesta.

No soy católica porque me guste el Papa. No soy católica porque los representantes humanos de la Iglesia tengan algo que ofrecerme (a menudo lo hacen, pero eso es otro tema).

Soy católica porque solo Pedro tiene la respuesta.

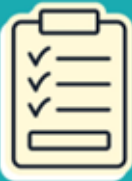

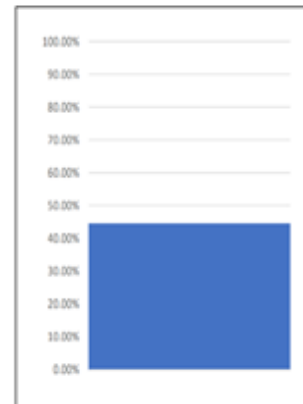
