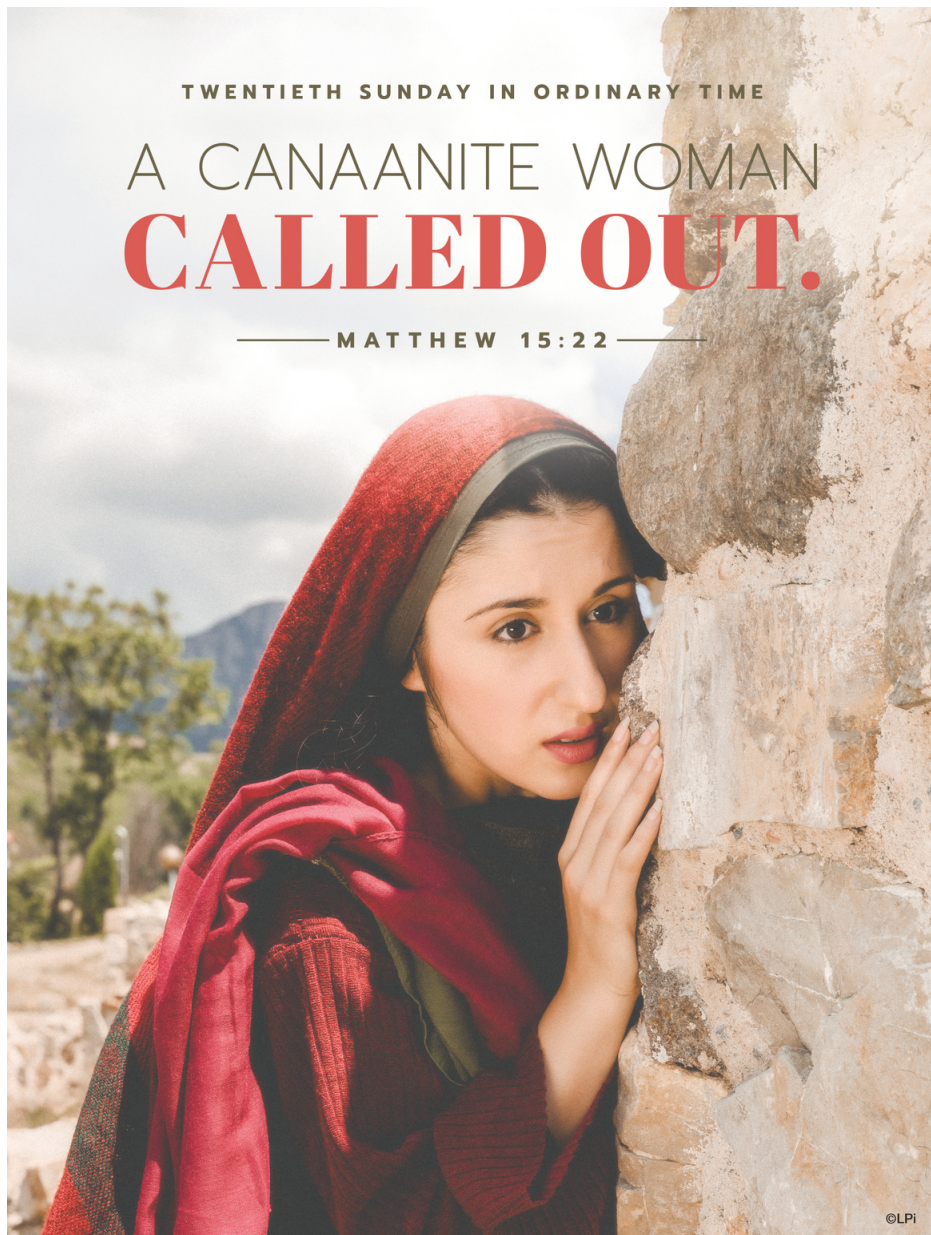

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

Thus says the Lord:
Observe what is right, do what is just;
for my salvation is about to come,
my justice, about to be revealed. (Is 56:1)

Psalm:

O God, let all the nations praise you! (Ps 67)

Second Reading:

For God delivered all to disobedience,
that he might have mercy upon all. (Rom 11:32)

Gospel:

Then Jesus said to her in reply,
“O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish.” (Mt 15:28)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

“I will bring them to my holy mountain and make them joyful in my house of prayer” (Isaiah 56:7). In other words, God accepts everyone, regardless of race or nationality. Many people are mistreated, humiliated, persecuted, or even killed because of their views and actions in the social or political spheres. Sometimes, persecution occurs even within the family, simply because of a difference of opinion. What does God ask of us in light of all this? What do you think of Jesus’s message as conveyed through His Word?

Today’s Gospel offers a lesson on accepting all people, drawing on the example of the Canaanite woman who sought compassion from Jesus for herself and her daughter. Although it may be hard to grasp, God does not act like human beings; He is not selfish, and He is there for everyone. The dialogue between Jesus and the woman demonstrates this. That is why He tells her: “Woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish.” And at that moment, her daughter was healed (Matthew 15:28). The message of God’s Word implies that we must learn something and put it into practice immediately: we need to examine our attitude and the way we treat others—especially those we view as different because they are immigrants or come from other countries or cultures. Jesus changes His stance in response to the woman’s request and, furthermore, commends her for her great faith. What does that change teach me? Let us ask the Lord to help us become better people and to cultivate a more open heart—one capable of respecting and accepting those who think and act differently than we do.

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Chess, Not Checkers

There’s a saying that good leaders have to play chess, not checkers.

It will surprise no one who knows me well that I am terrible at chess. It’s not so much a lack of skill (although that’s part of it) as a lack of effort. I find chess exhausting. To succeed at this complex game of strategy, you have to see not just the board in front of you, but the person in front of you — and more than that, you have to consider not just what is, but what could be.

I prefer checkers.

When I read a Gospel passage like today’s, I think of what Jesus would be like as a chess player. It’s so easy to see this account of the Canaanite woman and her tenacity and take it at face value, as a reminder to pray without ceasing, to never stop asking God for what we need. And certainly, it is that.

But it’s not only that.

We see a woman begging God for help, and we see God refuse — at first. We see her persist, and we see him capitulate. At least, that’s what it looks like to us.

What does it look like to Jesus?

Jesus sees this woman’s face and hears her words, just as his disciples do — but he also sees her heart. He sees her whole life. He sees every moment that leads up to this one. He sees her belief, but he also sees her unbelief. He sees her wounds. He sees her daughter.

He sees the game board not just for what it is, but for what it could be.

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera lectura:

Así dice el Señor:

Observad el derecho, practicad la justicia;

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

“Los llevaré a mi cerro santo y haré que se sientan felices en mi Casa de oración” (Isaías 56:7). Es decir, Dios acepta a todas las personas, sin distinción de raza o nación. Existen muchas personas que son maltratadas, humilladas o perseguidas, e incluso asesinadas, por su forma de pensar y de actuar en el ámbito social o político. En ocasiones, la persecución se da incluso dentro de la familia, tan solo por pensar diferente. ¿Qué nos pide Dios ante todo esto? ¿Qué opinas del mensaje de Jesús a través de su Palabra?

El Evangelio de hoy es una catequesis sobre la aceptación de todas las personas, a partir del ejemplo de la mujer cananea que buscaba en Jesús compasión para ella y para su hija. Aunque pueda resultar difícil de comprender, Dios no actúa como el ser humano: no es egoísta y está para todos. El diálogo entre Jesús y la mujer así lo demuestra. Por eso Él le dice: “Mujer, ¡qué grande es tu fe! Que se cumpla tu deseo”. Y en aquel momento quedó sana su hija (Mateo 15:28). El mensaje de la Palabra de Dios supone que debemos de aprender algo y ponerlo en práctica de inmediato: revisar nuestra actitud y la forma en que tratamos a los demás, especialmente a quienes consideramos diferentes por ser inmigrantes, de otro país o de otra cultura. Jesús cambia su actitud ante la petición de la mujer y, además, la enaltece por su gran fe. ¿Qué me enseña ese cambio? Pidamos al Señor que nos ayude a ser mejores y a tener un corazón más abierto, capaz de respetar y aceptar a las personas que piensan y actúan de manera diferente a nosotros.

Ajedrez, no Damas

Hay un dicho que dice que los buenos líderes tienen que jugar al ajedrez, no a las damas.

No sorprenderá a nadie que me conozca bien que soy terrible en el ajedrez. No es tanto falta de habilidad (aunque eso es parte de ello) sino una falta de esfuerzo. Encuentro el ajedrez agotador. Para tener éxito en este complejo juego de estrategia, tienes que ver no solo el tablero que tienes delante de ti, sino también a la persona que tienes delante de ti— y más que eso, tienes que considerar no solo lo que es, sino lo que podría ser.

Yo prefiero las damas.

Cuando leo un pasaje del Evangelio como el de hoy, pienso en cómo sería Jesús como jugador de ajedrez. Es tan fácil ver este relato de la mujer cananea y su tenacidad y tomarlo al pie de la letra, como un recordatorio para rezar sin cesar, para no dejar de pedir a Dios lo que necesitamos. Y desde luego, es eso.

Pero no es solo eso.

Vemos a una mujer suplicando ayuda a Dios, y vemos a Dios negarse — al principio. La vemos persistir, y vemos cómo él capitula. Al menos, eso es lo que nos parece a nosotros.

¿Cómo se ve para Jesús?

Jesús ve el rostro de esta mujer y escucha sus palabras, igual que sus discípulos — pero también ve su corazón. Él ve toda su vida. Ve cada momento que conduce a este. Él ve su creencia, pero también su incredulidad. Ve sus heridas. Ve a su hija.

Ve el tablero no solo por lo que es, sino por lo que podría ser.

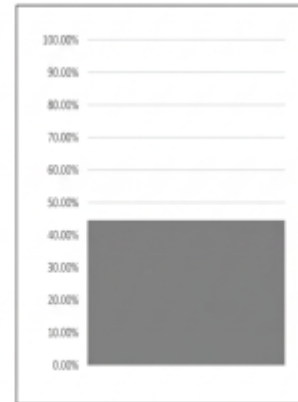
