### GOSPEL MEDITATION

#### The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed John 6:37-40

I lost my wallet this year. It was such an annoyance to replace everything in it. A friend, moved by sympathy, gave me a beautiful new one. One month later I lost that one, too, with all my newly replaced cards. No matter what I did, I couldn't find what I had lost. I resigned myself to never seeing either of my wallets again.

Fortunately, the Lord Jesus is not like me in this regard. In today's Gospel (John 6:37-40), he says, “**This is the will of the one who sent me, that I should not lose anything of what he gave me.**” Jesus, unlike me, is ever vigilant with what the Father has given him. He searches for every lost soul — as the shepherd leaves the ninety-nine to pursue the one lost sheep, or the woman rejoices upon recovering a lost coin — and even descends to the depths of loss on the cross and into the realm of the dead to recover that which seems forever lost.

On All Souls' Day, as we remember our faithful departed, these words kindle a hope beyond hope in our hearts. Even the dead are not lost to Jesus, though they may seem so to us. Nothing entrusted to him by the Father is ever truly lost. So, we may hope that every soul, no matter how wandering or forgotten in life, is secure in his loving care and destined to be raised on the last day. Of what the Father gives him, he loses nothing.

#### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS *By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman*

##### The Semicolon

My grave is in the corner of a cemetery in rural southeastern Wisconsin. For at least a mile in every direction, all you can see is farmland — cows, barns and quiet country roads. It's beautiful, serene. I imagine the hand of God writing me into existence — *she lived, she died* — using for ink the very dirt that fills this grave. The dust from which I was created.

Surrounding my grave are the burial plots of other family members — Rachel, Georgiana, Julian, Josephine. I visit the cemetery to pray for them, knowing they are there, but also not there. And when I visit their graves, I stand on my own. I look out at the tree-lined horizon and the farmland. I think of how, in a thousand years, none of this will be here. But I will be here, God's hand paused against the page, preparing to write the rest of the story not in dirt but in his own blood. For Christ does not lose anything of what the Father has given him.

Not a soul. Not a bone. Not a lock of hair.

*She lived, she died; she lived again.* No longer is there a period after the words *she died* but instead a semicolon. And the semicolon is the grave, that mystical place where the Blood mixes with the dust of the earth, where life meets death, and then meets life again. And the story continues.

# Oración Semanal, Adoración & Meditación

## MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

### La Conmemoración de Todos los Fieles Difuntos Juan 6:37-40

Este año perdí mi billetera. Fue una gran molestia tener que volver a colocar todo lo que contenía. Un amigo, conmovido por la compasión, me regaló una hermosa nueva. Un mes después, también la perdí, con todas mis tarjetas recién reemplazadas. Por mucho que hiciera, no podía encontrar lo que había perdido. Me resigné a no volver a ver ninguna de mis billeteras.

Afortunadamente, el Señor Jesús no es como yo en este sentido. En el Evangelio de hoy (Juan 6:37-40), dice: «Esta es la voluntad del que me envió: que no pierda nada de lo que me dio». Jesús, a diferencia de mí, siempre está atento a lo que el Padre le ha dado. Él busca a cada alma perdida —como el pastor deja a las noventa y nueve para ir en busca de la oveja perdida, o como la mujer se regocija al recuperar una moneda perdida— e incluso desciende a las profundidades de la pérdida en la cruz y al reino de los muertos para recuperar aquello que parece perdido para siempre.

En el Día de los Fieles Difuntos, al recordar a nuestros fieles difuntos, estas palabras encienden una esperanza inagotable en nuestros corazones. Ni siquiera los muertos están perdidos para Jesús, aunque nos parezca que sí. Nada de lo que el Padre le confía se pierde realmente. Por lo tanto, podemos tener la esperanza de que cada alma, por muy errante u olvidada que esté en la vida, esté segura bajo su amoroso cuidado y destinada a resucitar en el último día. De lo que el Padre le da, no pierde nada.

### El Punto y Coma

Mi tumba está en la esquina de un cementerio en el sureste rural de Wisconsin. Durante al menos una milla en todas las direcciones, todo lo que se puede ver son tierras de cultivo: vacas, graneros y tranquilos caminos rurales. Es hermoso, sereno. Me imagino la mano de Dios escribiéndome a la existencia — *ella vivió, ella murió* — usando como tinta la misma tierra que llena esta tumba. El polvo del que fui creada.

Alrededor de mi tumba están las parcelas funerarias de otros miembros de la familia: Rachel, Georgiana, Julian, Josephine. Visito el cementerio para rezar por ellos, sabiendo que están allí, pero también que no están allí. Y cuando visito sus tumbas, me paro sobre mi propia tumba. Miro el horizonte arbolado y las tierras de cultivo. Pienso en cómo, dentro de mil años, nada de esto estará aquí. Pero yo estaré aquí, con la mano de Dios detenida sobre la página, preparándose para escribir el resto de la historia, no en tierra, sino con su propia sangre. Porque Cristo no pierde nada de lo que el Padre le ha dado.


Ni un alma. Ni un hueso. Ni un mechón de pelo.






