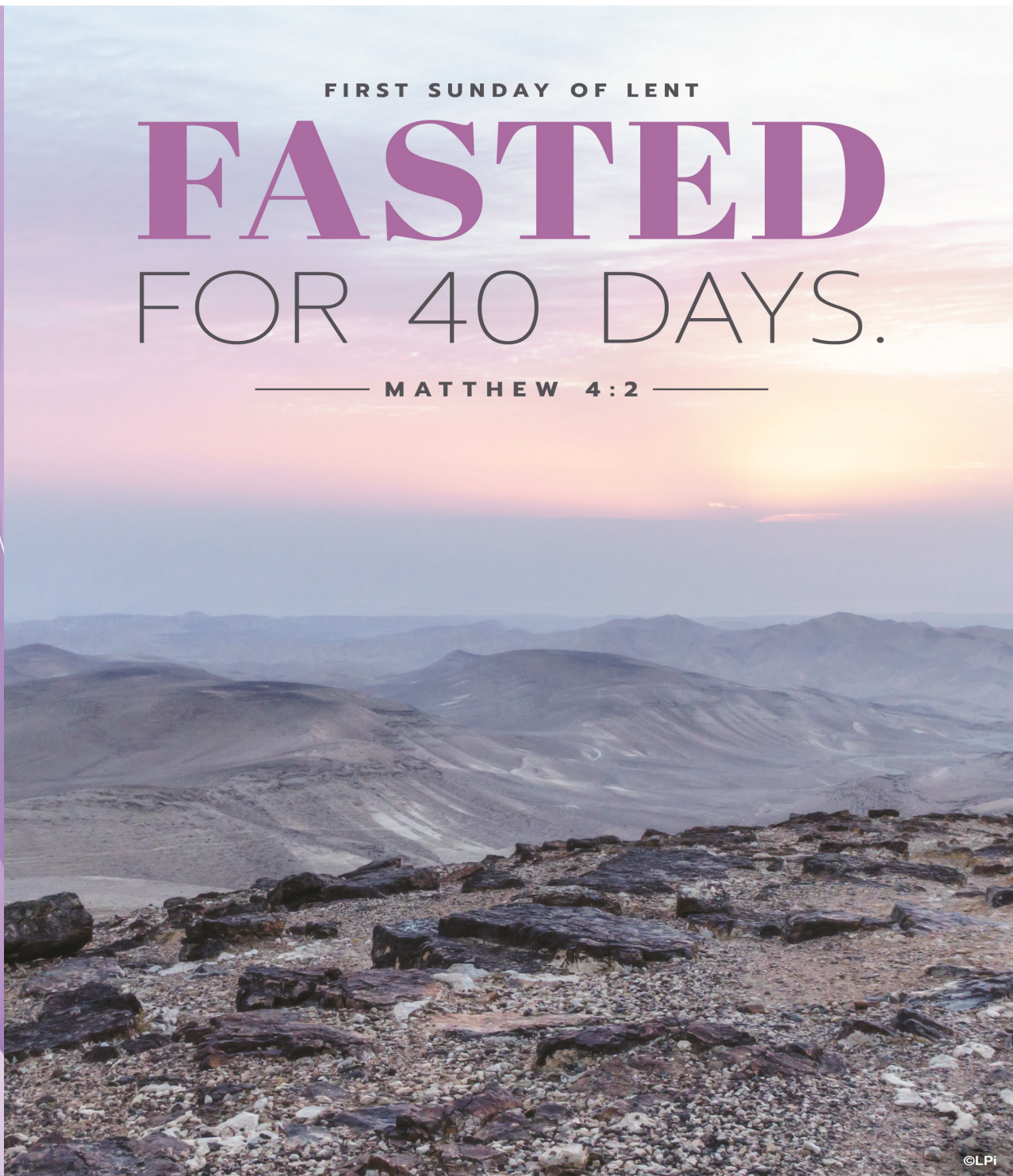

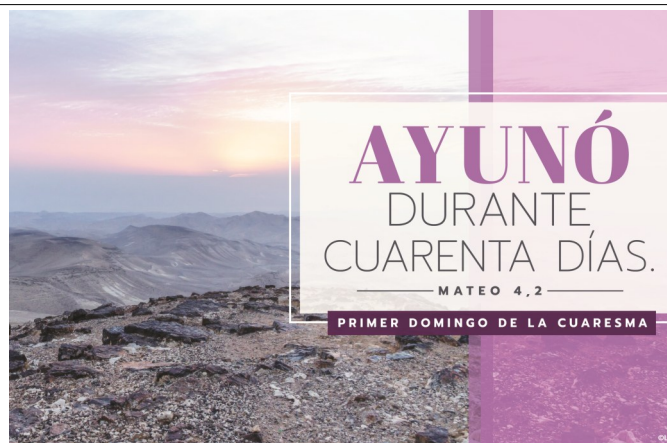

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

The LORD God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life. (Gn 2:7)

Psalm:

At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights. (Mt 4:1-2)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

1st Sunday of Lent

Matthew 4:1-11

In my second-to-last year of seminary, I woke up one September morning to devastating news: two beloved classmates had died in a car crash. I was overwhelmed with grief and anger like I had never known. I entered therapy for the first time and had intense conversations with my spiritual director. For months I felt lost in a spiritual wilderness. But something unexpected happened: I encountered Christ there. The fear and sorrow didn't destroy me. In fact, that spiritual desert was a time of intense growth in faith.

Today's Gospel begins: **"Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil" (Matthew 4:1).** The word "led" denotes a gentle, humble submission to the Spirit. Jesus does not send himself into this desolate place where wild beasts roam and Satan tempts. Who wants to be around roaming, wild beasts? The Church Fathers saw them as symbols of our inner chaos: fears, temptations, wounds. The Spirit leads us there, sometimes against our wishes. But those same Fathers also saw that this deserted place is also where angels ministered to Jesus, amidst his great trial and temptation.

Lenten Challenge: This Lent and throughout life's struggles, the Spirit leads you and me into the wilderness. Name one "desert" into which the Spirit has led you: perhaps grief, fear, silence, change, disappointment. Ask for the grace to go there willingly. The beasts may be real, but they will not harm you. There, the angels are waiting to minister to the Christ living in you, who always goes where the Spirit leads.

Into the Desert

When we first got married, I wanted to know everything my husband was thinking, exactly when he was thinking it.

Thirteen years later, I still want to know it all. But I want to know it after he's had a snack.

I think he still wants to know what I'm thinking, too. But he wants to know it after I've had 10 minutes without hearing the word, "Mommy!"

Life has taught us, you see, that it's hard to be a good person, a nice person, a gentle person, when your body doesn't feel good or nice or gentle. When you're hungry. When you're exhausted. When you're anxious.

It's not impossible, of course. It's just ... *hard*.

We're entering a penitential season, a time in which we purposefully deprive ourselves in certain ways. During Lent, we intentionally enter into the desert of physical hunger and weakness. Why, in preparation for Easter and in an effort to spiritually purify ourselves, do we go to this place where it's *so hard to be good*? Why do we go to the desert?

Because Christ has shown us that the desert is where decisions are made.

There are many reasons why the Word became flesh to accomplish God's plan for our salvation. But I think one of the most important reasons must have been that God wanted to show us that He knows, intimately, how easily the devil exploits our physical experience of this world. We see it in today's Gospel: Jesus, hungry and weary. Jesus, taunted and tempted.

We see him. We recognize him. We are him.

And we hear his voice, even though it trembles with fatigue: "Get away, Satan!"

Today, we enter the desert. Because the desert is where decisions are made.

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Primer Domingo de Cuaresma

Mateo 4:1-11

En mi penúltimo año de seminario, me desperté una mañana de septiembre con una noticia devastadora: dos queridos compañeros de clase habían muerto en un accidente de coche. Me invadió un dolor y una ira como nunca antes. Acudí a terapia por primera vez y tuve conversaciones intensas con mi director espiritual. Durante meses me sentí perdido en un desierto espiritual. Pero sucedió algo inesperado: allí encontré a Cristo. El miedo y la tristeza no me destruyeron. De hecho, ese desierto espiritual fue un tiempo de intenso crecimiento en la fe.

El Evangelio de hoy comienza: «Entonces Jesús fue llevado por el Espíritu al desierto para ser tentado por el diablo» (Mateo 4:1). La palabra «llevado» denota una sumisión mansa y humilde al Espíritu. Jesús no se envía a este lugar desolado donde vagan fieras y Satanás tienta. ¿Quién quiere estar rodeado de fieras vagabundas? Los Padres de la Iglesia los vieron como símbolos de nuestro caos interior: miedos, tentaciones, heridas. El Espíritu nos lleva allí, a veces en contra de nuestra voluntad. Pero esos mismos Padres también vieron que este lugar desierto es donde los ángeles ministraron a Jesús, en medio de su gran prueba y tentación.

Desafío Cuaresmal: Esta Cuaresma y a lo largo de las luchas de la vida, el Espíritu nos guía a ti y a mí al desierto. Nombra un "desierto" al que el Espíritu te haya llevado: quizás dolor, miedo, silencio, cambio, decepción. Pide la gracia de ir allí voluntariamente. Las bestias pueden ser reales, pero no te harán daño. Allí, los ángeles esperan para ministrar al Cristo que vive en ti, quien siempre va a donde el Espíritu te guía.— Padre John Muir

En el Desierto

Cuando estábamos recién casados, yo quería saber todo lo que mi esposo estaba pensando, exactamente cuando él lo estaba pensando. Trece años después, todavía quiero saberlo todo. Pero quiero saberlo después de que haya comido un refrigerio.

Creo que él todavía quiere saber lo que estoy pensando también. Pero quiere saberlo después de que haya tenido 10 minutos sin escuchar la palabra "¡Mami!"

La vida nos ha enseñado, como ves, que es difícil ser una buena persona, una linda persona, una persona amable, cuando tu cuerpo no se siente bien, agradable o gentil. Cuando tienes hambre. Cuando estás agotado. Cuando estás ansioso. No es imposible, por supuesto. Es solo... *difícil*.

Estamos entrando en una temporada penitencial, un tiempo en el que nos privamos a propósito de ciertas maneras. Durante la Cuaresma, entramos intencionalmente en el desierto del hambre y la debilidad física. ¿Por qué, en preparación para la Pascua y en un esfuerzo por purificarnos espiritualmente, vamos a este lugar donde es *tan difícil ser bueno*? ¿Por qué vamos al desierto?

Porque Cristo nos ha mostrado que el desierto es donde se toman las decisiones.

Hay muchas razones por las que el Verbo se hizo carne para cumplir el plan de Dios para nuestra salvación. Pero creo que una de las razones más importantes debe haber sido que Dios quería mostrarnos que Él sabe, íntimamente, con qué facilidad el diablo explota nuestra experiencia física de este mundo. Lo vemos en el Evangelio de hoy: Jesús, hambriento y cansado. Jesús, burlado y tentado.

Lo vemos. Lo reconocemos. Somos él. Y escuchamos su voz, aunque tiembla de fatiga: "¡Aléjate, Satanás!" Hoy, entramos en el desierto. Porque el desierto es donde se toman las decisiones.

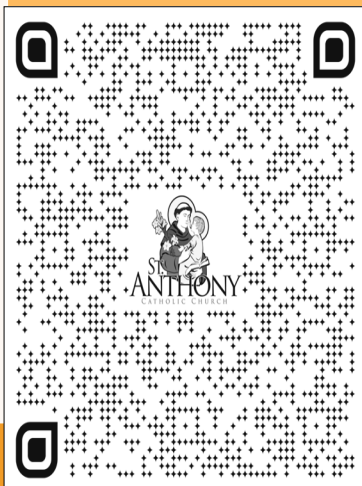

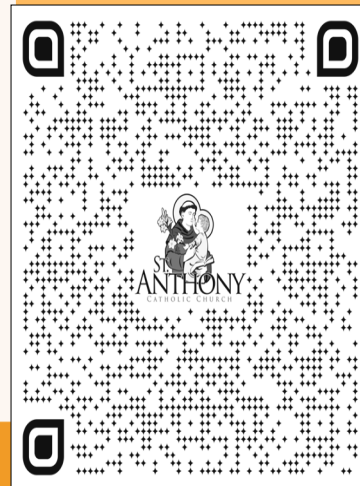
