

### SUNDAY'S READINGS

#### First Reading:

Then Samuel, with the horn of oil in hand, anointed David in the presence of his brothers; and from that day on, the spirit of the LORD rushed upon David. (1 Sm 16:13)

#### Psalm:

The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. (Ps 23)

#### Second Reading:

“Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.” (Eph 5:14)

#### Gospel:

He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva, and smeared the clay on his eyes, and said to him, “Go wash in the Pool of Siloam” — which means Sent — . So he went and washed, and came back able to see. (Jn 9:6-7)

### GOSPEL MEDITATION

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent

#### John 9:1-41

If you are like me, it's easy to fixate on our shadows: failures, guilt, shame. Especially when we suffer, it is easy to want to blame ourselves or others. In this week's Gospel, Jesus' disciples ask about the blind man, “**Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents?**” (John 9:2) They, like us, focus on blame. But Jesus sees the entire situation differently: “**Neither he nor his parents sinned; it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him.**” He does not deny sin, but he sees deeper — through the light of mercy, not the lens of judgment. The scene hinges on Jesus' strange claim: “**I am the light of the world**” (John 9:5). He sees things differently than everyone. They see shadows and light. He is the light. Thought experiment: imagine you are the sun looking at everything on the earth. What do you see? Everything. What do you *not* see? Shadows. Everything is illuminated. If you see it, it is illuminated. For the light, nothing is dark.

Because he is the light, Jesus sees us in the glow of his redemptive love. Even our sin becomes a place where his glory can shine. The man's healing is not just about sight — it is about seeing as Christ sees. Lent is not a season of staring into darkness. It is a time to step into the light — to let Christ's gaze reframe how we see ourselves and one another.

**Lenten challenge:** Spend 10 quiet minutes this week asking Jesus to show you how he sees you. Not through shame or fear, but through the light of his mercy.

#### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS *By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman*

I don't know about you. But if I was a blind person sitting by the side of the road, minding my own business, and a stranger came along and rubbed spit-mud in my eye, I'm just salty enough that I would ignore his words out of spite.

Even though he was, admittedly, super-nice about the whole thing.

Obviously I would wash the mud out, because ... spit. But I wouldn't go to the Pool of Siloam. I would go to a pool on the *whole other side of town*, just to be contrary. I would make frustrated, grossed-out noises while I splashed water on my eyes: “Ugh! I can't believe this! People are the worst!” I would feel satisfied that I wasn't tricked or conned or taken advantage of.

And I would stay blind the rest of my life.

When Jesus performs a miracle in the Gospel, we sometimes think of it like a fireworks show. Something people point at — “Ooh! Aah!” — and move on from. But a miracle of Jesus is not a party trick. It is a commissioning.

And each of us, in our own way, has the choice of accepting it or not.

Nowhere in the Gospel story does it say that Jesus promised the man sight if he washed in the pool. I wonder what it was that made the blind man feel he could trust Jesus. Was it something in his voice? Was it something in his touch? Was it the humanity with which he spoke of the blind man to his disciples — a gentleness missing from most other interactions of his life?

We'll never know. But we do know this: the blind man's sight wasn't restored until he made a decision. A decision to be sent.

# Oración Semanal, Adoración & Meditación

## LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

### Primera Lectura:

Samuel, con el cuerno de aceite en la mano, ungió a David en presencia de sus hermanos; y desde aquel día, el Espíritu del Señor se apoderó de David. (1 Samuel 16:13)

### Salmo:

El Señor es mi pastor; nada me falta. (Salmo 23)

### Segunda Lectura:

“Despierta, tú que duermes, y levántate de entre los muertos, y Cristo te iluminará.” (Efesios 5:14)

### Evangelio:

Escupió en tierra, hizo barro con la saliva, y le untó el barro en los ojos, y le dijo: “Ve a lavarte a la piscina de Siloé” (que significa Enviado). Fue, se lavó y volvió con la vista. (Juan 9:6-7)

## MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

### 4.º Domingo de Cuaresma

#### Juan 9:1-41

Si eres como yo, es fácil obsesionarse con nuestras sombras: fracasos, culpa, vergüenza. Especialmente cuando sufrimos, es fácil querer culparnos a nosotros mismos o a los demás. En el Evangelio de esta semana, los discípulos de Jesús preguntan por el ciego: «Rabí, ¿quién pecó, este o sus padres?» (Juan 9:2). Ellos, como nosotros, se centran en la culpa. Pero Jesús ve la situación de otra manera: «Ni él ni sus padres pecaron; es para que las obras de Dios se manifiesten a través de él». No niega el pecado, pero ve más profundamente, a través de la luz de la misericordia, no a través de la lente del juicio. La escena gira en torno a la extraña afirmación de Jesús: «Yo soy la luz del mundo» (Juan 9:5). Él ve las cosas de forma diferente a todos. Ellos ven sombras y luz. Él es la luz.

Experimento mental: imagina que eres el sol mirando todo en la tierra. ¿Qué ves? Todo. ¿Qué no ves?

Sombras. Todo está iluminado. Si lo ves, está iluminado. Para la luz, nada es oscuro.

Porque él es la luz, Jesús nos ve en el resplandor de su amor redentor. Incluso nuestro pecado se convierte en un lugar donde su gloria puede brillar. La sanación del hombre no se trata solo de la vista, sino de ver como Cristo ve. La Cuaresma no es un tiempo para contemplar la oscuridad. Es un tiempo para salir a la luz, para dejar que la mirada de Cristo redefina cómo nos vemos a nosotros mismos y a los demás.

Desafío Cuaresmal: Dedicar 10 minutos de silencio esta semana a pedirle a Jesús que te muestre cómo te ve. No a través de la vergüenza ni el miedo, sino a través de la luz de su misericordia.

### RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

No sé tú. Pero si yo fuera una persona ciega sentada al lado del camino, ocupándome de mis propios asuntos, y un extraño viniera y me frotara barro con saliva en mis ojos, soy lo suficientemente de carácter salado como para ignorar sus palabras solo por despecho.

A pesar de que, sin duda, fue súper amable con todo el asunto.

Obviamente me quitaría el barro, porque... saliva. Pero no iría a la piscina de Siloé. Iría a una piscina en el *otro lado de la ciudad*, solo para ser contraria. Haría ruidos frustrados y de asco mientras me salpicara agua en los ojos: "¡Uf! ¡No puedo creerlo! ¡La gente es lo peor!" Me sentiría satisfecha de que no me engañaran, estafaran o se aprovecharan de mí.

Y me quedaría ciega el resto de mi vida.

Cuando Jesús realiza un milagro en el Evangelio, a veces pensamos en ello como un espectáculo de fuegos artificiales. Algo que la gente señala: "¡Ooh! ¡Aah!" - y se olvida. Pero un milagro de Jesús no es un truco de fiesta. Es una puesta en marcha.

Y cada uno de nosotros, a su manera, tiene la opción de aceptarla o no.

En ninguna parte de la historia del Evangelio dice que Jesús le prometió al hombre la vista si se lavaba en la piscina. Me pregunto qué fue lo que hizo que el ciego sintiera que podía confiar en Jesús. ¿Era algo en su voz? ¿Era algo en su toque? ¿Fue la humanidad con la que habló del ciego a sus discípulos, una dulzura que faltaba en la mayoría de las otras interacciones de su vida?

Nunca lo sabremos. Pero sí sabemos esto: la vista del ciego no fue restaurada hasta que tomó una decisión. Una decisión de ser enviado.






