



GOSPEL MEDITATION

3rd Sunday of Lent

John 4:5-42

Recently I received a note from a teenager I met years ago. He wrote, "Dear Father Muir, you probably do not remember me, but I wanted to thank you for your inspiring and humorous homilies at the parish. They helped me appreciate the beauty of Catholicism, which I have now embraced in a personal way." That small note moved me more than he probably imagined. I had no idea my words had taken root in him. I was simply sowing seeds — week by week, Mass by Mass. Someone else — his parents, a youth minister, or God Himself — was doing the deeper work. Now this young man is joyfully reaping a harvest of faith. In today's Gospel, Jesus offers living water to a Samaritan woman whose life had been full of searching and disappointment. By the end of their encounter, she becomes a bold and joyful evangelist. Then Jesus turns to his disciples and says something easily overlooked: "**One sows and another reaps**" (John 4:37). He is helping them — and us — understand how evangelization works. Often, the one who sows the seeds of faith is not the one who sees the fruit.

This Lent, ask yourself: Are you in a sowing phase or a reaping phase? If you are sowing — raising children, praying for someone, mentoring — be patient. Your work matters. If you are reaping — seeing someone come alive in faith — be grateful. You are standing on sacred ground, tilled and watered by others.

Lenten challenge: Thank someone who once sowed faith into your life. And keep sowing, even when the harvest is unseen.

When God asks for Water

One of my earliest memories is of my mother weeping.

The last few months of her pregnancy with my little brother were tremendously painful for her, and more than once the pain brought her to tears. I have a hazy image of her in my mind, belly swollen with a 12-pound baby lying transverse in the womb, sitting on the edge of her bed, dabbing at her face with toilet paper.

I had brought her the toilet paper. I would do that when I saw her crying, to wipe away her tears. I have a hazy memory of that, too — of the way my heart was wrenched by the sight of her suffering, of my desperation to do something to help, and of my immense satisfaction when she would take the toilet paper, smile and say, "Oh, thank you, sweetheart!" as if I had just airlifted her out of a war zone.

What a powerful gift to give to a child still learning the meaning of compassion and selflessness — the gift of being able to feel that she has, even in some small way, "rescued" a person she worships. Her smile of gratitude lives, immortal, in my mind, along with the swell of satisfaction it produced in the deepest corner of my heart. This was when I learned that it feels good to help people, and this memory is a perpetually replenished well of living water for me. I draw from it daily, three decades later.

This is a gift that Christ gives, over and over again, in the Gospels. He allows us to encounter him tired, afraid, sad and hungry. Omnipotent power subjected to the utter vulnerability of human form.

Before the Incarnation, God looked down from Heaven and said, "You are thirsty. Here is something to drink."

After the Incarnation, God sits down beside us and says, "I'm thirsty. Give me something to drink."

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma

Juan 4:5-42

Recientemente recibí una nota de un adolescente que conocí hace años. Escribió: “Querido Padre Muir, probablemente no me recuerde, pero quería agradecerle sus inspiradoras y divertidas homilias en la parroquia. Me ayudaron a apreciar la belleza del catolicismo, que ahora he abrazado de forma personal”. Esa breve nota me conmovió más de lo que probablemente imaginó. No tenía ni idea de que mis palabras habían arraigado en él. Simplemente estaba sembrando semillas, semana tras semana, misa tras misa. Alguien más —sus padres, un pastor juvenil o Dios mismo— estaba haciendo el trabajo más profundo. Ahora este joven está cosechando con alegría una cosecha de fe.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús ofrece agua viva a una mujer samaritana cuya vida había estado llena de búsqueda y decepción. Al final de su encuentro, ella se convierte en una evangelizadora valiente y alegre. Entonces Jesús se dirige a sus discípulos y dice algo que fácilmente se pasa por alto: «Uno siembra y otro cosecha» (Juan 4:37). Les está ayudando, y a nosotros también, a comprender cómo funciona la evangelización. A menudo, quien siembra la fe no es quien ve el fruto.

Esta Cuaresma, pregúntate: ¿Estás en fase de siembra o de cosecha? Si estás sembrando —criando hijos, orando por alguien, acompañando—, sé paciente. Tu trabajo importa. Si estás cosechando —viendo a alguien cobrar vida en la fe—, sé agradecido. Estás pisando tierra sagrada, cultivada y regada por otros.

Reto cuaresmal: Agradece a alguien que una vez sembró la fe en tu vida. Y sigue sembrando, incluso cuando la cosecha sea invisible.

Cuando Dios Pide Agua

Uno de mis primeros recuerdos es de mi madre llorando.

Los últimos meses de su embarazo con mi hermanito fueron tremendamente dolorosos para ella, y más de una vez el dolor la hizo llorar. Tengo una imagen borrosa de ella en mi mente, con el vientre hinchado con un bebé de 12 libras acostado transversalmente en el útero, sentada en el borde de su cama, frotándose la cara con papel higiénico.

Le había traído el papel higiénico. Lo hacía cuando la veía llorar, para secarse las lágrimas. También tengo un vago recuerdo de eso: de la forma en que mi corazón se desgarraba al ver su sufrimiento, de mi desesperación por hacer algo para ayudar, y de mi inmensa satisfacción cuando tomaba el papel higiénico, sonreía y decía: "¡Oh, gracias, cariño!" como si acabara de sacarla en avión de una zona de guerra.

Qué regalo tan poderoso para darle a un niño que aún está aprendiendo el significado de la compasión y el altruismo, el regalo de poder sentir que, aunque sea de alguna manera, ha "rescatado" a una persona a la que adora. Su sonrisa de gratitud vive, inmortal, en mi mente, junto con la oleada de satisfacción que produjo en lo más profundo de mi corazón. Fue entonces cuando aprendí que se siente bien ayudar a las personas, y este recuerdo es un pozo de agua viva perpetuamente renovado para mí. Saco de él a diario, tres décadas después.

Este es un don que Cristo da, una y otra vez, en los Evangelios. Nos permite encontrarlo cansado, asustado, triste y hambriento. Poder omnipotente sometido a la absoluta vulnerabilidad de la forma humana.

Antes de la Encarnación, Dios miró desde el Cielo y dijo: "Tienes sed. Aquí hay algo para beber".

Después de la Encarnación, Dios se sienta a nuestro lado y dice: "Tengo sed. Dame algo de beber".




