

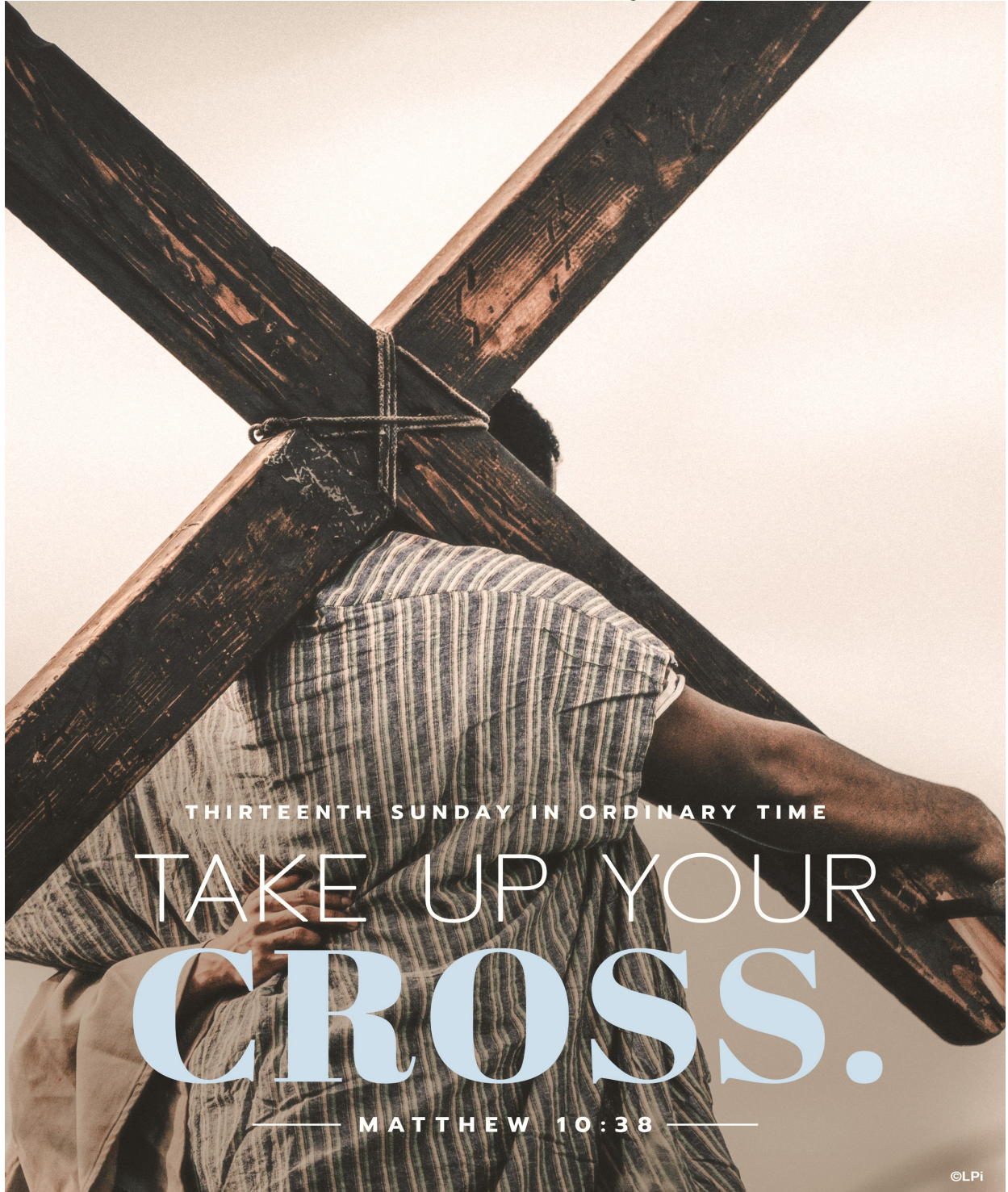

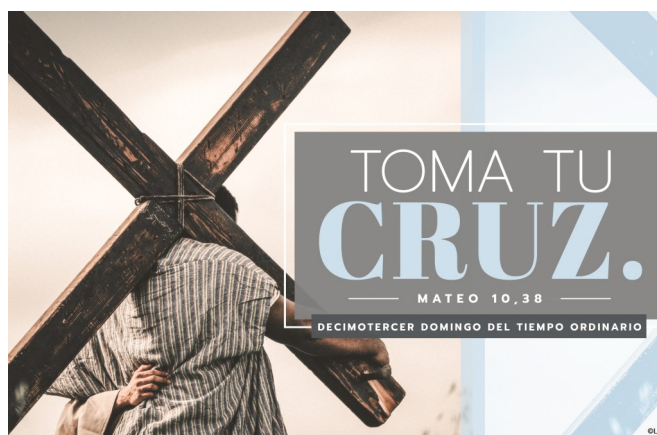

GOSPEL MEDITATION

13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 10:37-42

I still remember the first homily I ever preached as a new deacon. It was at the seminary, and the Gospel was this one: "**Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me.**" (Matthew 10:37-38) Standing before more than 200 classmates and professors, I stumbled awkwardly through my words and realized how strange — almost insane — this teaching sounded. If anyone else said it, we would call it narcissistic or cultish.

And that is the point. I felt the weight of those words in my own heart then, as I still do today. Am I willing to live as though Christ's claim on my love is absolute? Are you?

Over the years, I've learned that the more I do, the more everything else makes sense. Family, friendships, vocation, even my very self: all of it falls into place when my love for Jesus comes first.

That is why he dares to speak this way. Our Lord is not a cult leader hungry for control. He is the Son of God, the source of life and love itself. To put him before everything else is not to lose, but to find... everything, and everyone, in him.

This week, name one thing or one person you are tempted to place before the Lord. Then consciously offer it back to him in prayer.

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS *By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman*

Receiving

I receive a lot of junk mail. I'm on a bunch of people's asking-for-money lists, and so were the people who owned this house before me, and when you put it all together, it results in quite the pile of paper accumulating on my counter.

I leave it there because, while I have received this mail, I don't want to *receive* it. Do you see the difference? To really receive someone or something, you have to look at it, assess it, make space for it. Accept it. Decide it will have a place in your home or your life or whatever, and give it that place.

It's what the righteous woman did with Elisha. She received him. She had a room all ready, waiting for him, even when he wasn't there.

But I refuse to receive the junk mail. I don't have space for it, in my head or on my counter, so after a day or two, I just throw it away without looking through it.

"Whoever receives me receives the one who sent me," Jesus tells us in the Gospel of Matthew.

But what does that mean, exactly?

It's easy to receive Jesus, or at least to receive the Jesus presented to us by modern imagination — that laidback hippie who lets anyone sit at his table, no questions asked. But it's harder to receive the Christ, God the Son, who is consubstantial with God the Father who sent him.

Ah, yes, God the Father — maybe you've heard of Him? He's the one from the Old Testament who says and does a bunch of things that make modern people uncomfortable.

That's a little more of a challenge, isn't it? Takes a little bit more thought. A little more assessment. A little more making-space.

Can we do it? Well, we have to find a way. Because for the record, laidback hippie Jesus doesn't exist. And Old Testament God makes a lot of sense, if you give Him a little thought. If you make a little space.

So make the space. Receive.

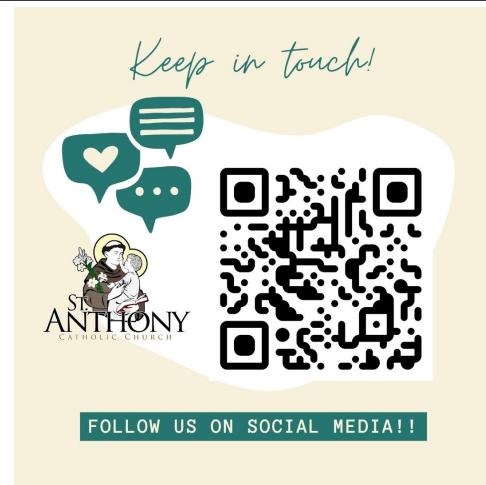

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera lectura:

Cuando llamaron a la mujer y ella se presentó a la puerta, Eliseo le prometió: «Para esta misma época el año que viene, estarás acariciando a un hijo varón». (2 Re 4, 15-16)

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

XIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Mateo 10, 37-42

Todavía recuerdo la primera homilía que prediqué como diácono recién ordenado. Fue en el seminario y el Evangelio era este: «**El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí**» (Mateo 10, 37-38). De pie ante más de 200 compañeros y profesores, pronuncié mis palabras con cierta torpeza y me di cuenta de lo extraña —casi descabellada— que sonaba esta enseñanza. Si cualquier otra persona dijera algo así, lo calificaríamos de narcisista o propio de una secta.

Y ahí radica el punto clave. Sentí el peso de esas palabras en mi propio corazón entonces, tal como lo siento hoy. ¿Estoy dispuesto a vivir como si la exigencia de Cristo sobre mi amor fuera absoluta? ¿Y tú?

Con el paso de los años, he aprendido que cuanto más vivo de esta manera, más sentido cobra todo lo demás. La familia, las amistades, la vocación e incluso mi propia persona: todo encuentra su lugar cuando mi amor por Jesús ocupa el primer puesto. Por eso Él se atreve a hablar así. Nuestro Señor no es el líder de una secta ávido de control. Él es el Hijo de Dios, la fuente de la vida y del amor mismo. Ponerlo a Él por encima de todo no significa perder, sino encontrar... todo y a todos en Él.

Esta semana, identifica una cosa o una persona a la que te sientas tentado a anteponer al Señor. Luego, ofrécesela conscientemente a Él en oración.

Es lo que hizo la mujer justa con Eliseo. Ella lo recibió. Tenía una habitación lista, esperándolo, incluso cuando él no estaba.

Pero me niego a recibir el correo basura. No tengo espacio para él, ni en mi cabeza ni en el mostrador, así que después de uno o dos días simplemente lo tiro sin mirarlo.

"El que me recibe, recibe al que me envió", nos dice Jesús en el Evangelio de Mateo.

Pero ¿qué significa eso exactamente?

Es fácil recibir a Jesús, o al menos recibir al Jesús que nos presenta la imaginación moderna — ese hippie relajado que deja que cualquiera se siente en su mesa sin hacer preguntas. Pero es más difícil recibir a Cristo, Dios Hijo, que es consubstancial con Dios Padre que le envió.

Ah, sí, Dios Padre — ¿quizá hayas oído hablar de Él? Es el que dice y hace un montón de cosas que incomodan a la gente moderna.

Eso es un poco más complicado, ¿no? Requiere un poco más de reflexión. Un poco más de valoración. Un poco más de espacio.

¿Podemos hacerlo? Bueno, tenemos que encontrar la manera. Porque, para que conste, el relajado, hippie Jesús no existe. Y el Dios del Antiguo Testamento tiene mucho sentido, si le das un poco de vuelta. Si haces un poco de espacio.

Así que haz espacio. Recibe.

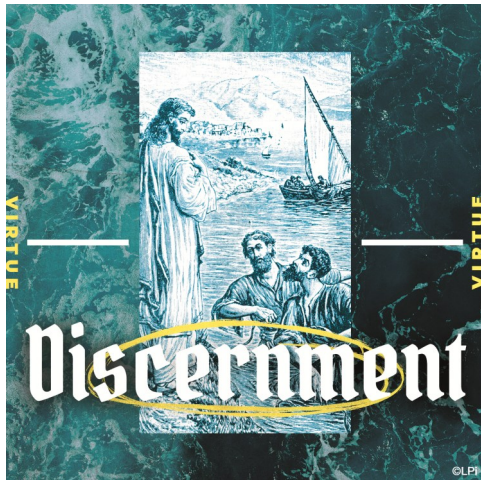

Discernment, Explained!

We most often hear the term “discernment” when a man or woman prayerfully considers a religious vocation. This is a helpful context in which to think of the virtue of discernment, which all Christians are called to develop, lay and religious alike.

When a person hears a “call,” he cannot simply *go* — he must first figure out where the call is coming from. It’s not enough to simply have an idea of becoming a priest, a sister, a missionary, a husband, a wife — the idea needs a good, thorough background check. This is discernment, which “unmasks the lie of temptation, whose object appears to be good...when in reality its fruit is death,” says the Catechism. (CCC 2846)

We run this background check of discernment on our feelings, our intentions, and our inclinations under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and through a diligent regimen of prayer and reflection. “The Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius” is highly regarded as a useful tool for spiritual discernment.

Prayer for Those Discerning Marriage

Dear Jesus,

Bless the men and women in our community who are looking for a good spouse. Be their dearest companion through the ups and downs of discernment. Bring them godly partners with good hearts set on you, so that together they might build families equipped to shine your light on the world.

¡Discernimiento, Explicado!

Con mayor frecuencia escuchamos el término "discernimiento" cuando un hombre o una mujer considera en oración una vocación religiosa. Este es un contexto útil para pensar en la virtud del discernimiento, que todos los cristianos están llamados a desarrollar, tanto laicos como religiosos.

Cuando una persona escucha un "llamado", no puede simplemente irse — primero debe averiguar de dónde viene el llamado. No basta con tener simplemente la idea de convertirse en sacerdote, hermana, misionero, esposo, o esposa: la idea necesita una buena y exhaustiva verificación de antecedentes. Esto es discernimiento, que "desenmascara la mentira de la tentación, cuyo objetivo parece ser el bien... cuando en realidad su fruto es la muerte", dice el Catecismo. (CCC 2846)

Realizamos esta comprobación de antecedentes de discernimiento sobre nuestros sentimientos, nuestras intenciones y nuestras inclinaciones bajo la guía del Espíritu Santo y mediante un régimen diligente de oración y reflexión. "Los Ejercicios Espirituales de San Ignacio" son muy valorados como una herramienta útil para el discernimiento espiritual.

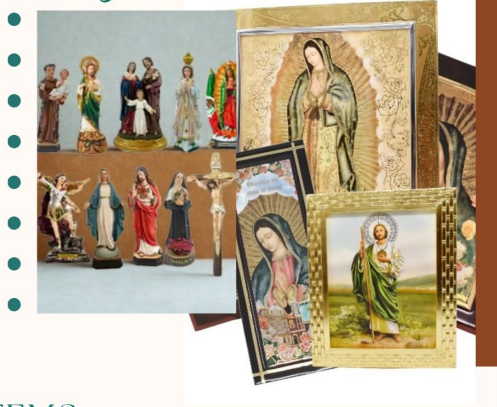

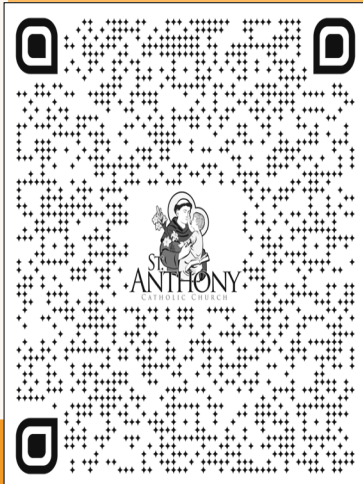

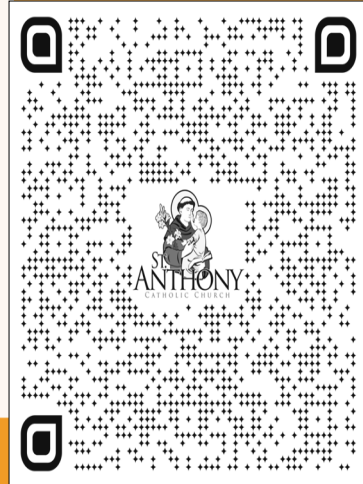
