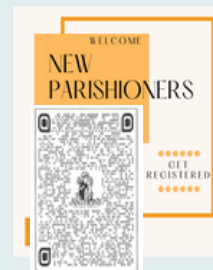

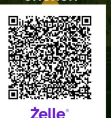

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven. (Sir 28:2)

Psalm:

The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger, and rich in compassion. (Ps 103)

Second Reading:

None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord. (Rom 14:8)

Gospel:

Peter approached Jesus and asked him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times." (Mt 18:21-22)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Matthew 18:21-35

I believe that at some point in our lives, we have been betrayed and have also betrayed others. Consequently, we have all struggled to forgive and to be forgiven. This Sunday, God's Word invites us to experience His merciful love through forgiveness. To dwell in His Kingdom, we must harbor no resentment; on the contrary, our hearts must be open to forgiveness. Pope Leo XIV, in his catechesis on forgiveness, tells us: "He has understood that the freedom of the other—even when they have gone astray into evil—can still be reached by the light of a gentle gesture. For he knows that true forgiveness does not wait for repentance but is offered first, as a free gift, even before it is accepted." It is in this way that God's love is revealed to each person.

"Understanding God's mercy is a mystery; yet the greatest and most beautiful mystery is the heart of God. If you wish to go straight to the heart of God, take the path of mercy and allow yourself to be treated with mercy" (Pope Francis, September 21, 2018). This means that a Christian's forgiveness must resemble the forgiveness God grants us. Whom must I forgive? For what do I need forgiveness within my family? Lord, heal my wounds; they are many and sometimes embitter my soul, but with Your help, they will heal, and I will then be able to offer that same forgiveness to others.

Mercy You Can Feel

"You qualify for forgiveness," I heard the woman on the other end of the phone tell me, and I surprised myself by starting to weep.

I had called the hospital system's financial services department to set up a payment plan on a balance I owed after having some unexpected scans and tests. I was hoping to minimize the dent our family's savings took — transform one devastating wallop into a series of more easily absorbed blows, so to speak.

Imagine my surprise when I realized the hospital was pulling its punch. If you have ever had a financial debt forgiven, you know the relief that came over me in that moment.

It wasn't until a little later that the guilt set in. I know so many people who have medical debt. Why was I able to get out of paying, and they were not?

But the cold, hard truth is that I didn't "get out" of anything. My insurance, for which I pay, had given the hospital enough money to cover the true cost of the procedures. That balance would merely have increased the hospital's profit.

Make no mistake: capitalism does not forgive.

If you describe the Sacrament of Reconciliation to someone unfamiliar with theology, chances are they'll think God is a chump. "You get to go in, say you're sorry, and leave — and everything's just fine?" someone once asked me in disbelief.

Well, yeah. That's forgiveness.

Real mercy cannot be budgeted. It must be given recklessly, extravagantly, against all reason. It must cost the giver. It must scandalize any accountant worth his salt. And no one "qualifies."

If I can't wrap my head around the idea, it might mean I'm stuck in a for-profit paradigm of justice. It might just mean that I need to engage more in real mercy. Mercy I can feel.

Evangelio:

Pedro se acercó a Jesús y le preguntó: «Señor, si mi hermano peca contra mí, ¿cuántas veces debo perdonarlo? ¿Hasta siete veces?» Jesús le respondió: «Te digo que no siete veces, sino setenta y siete veces». (Mt 18, 21-22)

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Mateo 18:21-35

Creo que en algún momento de nuestra vida hemos sido traicionados y también hemos traicionado. Por lo tanto, todos hemos luchado por perdonar y por ser perdonados. La Palabra de Dios, este domingo, nos invita a experimentar el amor misericordioso de Dios por medio del perdón. Para habitar en su Reino no debemos guardar rencor alguno; por el contrario, el corazón debe estar abierto al perdón. El Papa León XIV, en sus catequesis sobre el perdón, nos dice lo siguiente: “Ha comprendido que la libertad del otro, incluso cuando se extravía en el mal, todavía puede alcanzarse con la luz de un gesto manso. Porque sabe que el verdadero perdón no espera el arrepentimiento, sino que se ofrece primero, como un don gratuito, incluso antes de ser acogido”. Así, de esta manera, se manifiesta el amor de Dios a cada persona.

“Comprender la misericordia de Dios es un misterio; pero el misterio más grande y más bello es el corazón de Dios. Si quieres ir directo al corazón de Dios, toma el camino de la misericordia y déjate tratar con misericordia” (Papa Francisco, 21-09-2018). Esto significa que el perdón del cristiano debe asemejarse al perdón que Dios nos concede. ¿A quién debo perdonar? ¿De qué debo ser perdonado en mi familia? Señor, sana mis heridas; son muchas y a veces amargan mi alma, pero con tu ayuda sanarán, y así podré ofrecer a otros el mismo perdón.

Misericordia que Puedes Sentir

"Tú calificas para el perdón", oí decirme a la mujer al otro lado del teléfono, y me sorprendí a mí misma al empezar a llorar.

Llamé al departamento de servicios financieros del sistema hospitalario para establecer un plan de pagos sobre un saldo que debía tras hacerme algunos escáneres y pruebas inesperados. Esperaba minimizar el golpe que sufrieron los ahorros de nuestra familia — transformar un golpe devastador en una serie de golpes más fáciles de absorber, por así decirlo.

Imagina mi sorpresa cuando me di cuenta de que el hospital suavizaría el golpe. Si alguna vez te han perdonado una deuda financiera, sabes el alivio que sentí en ese momento.

No fue hasta un poco más tarde cuando la culpa se instaló. Conozco a muchísima gente que tiene deudas médicas. ¿Por qué pude librarme de pagar y ellos no?

Pero la dura y fría verdad es que no "salí" de nada. Mi seguro, por el que pago, había dado al hospital suficiente dinero para cubrir el costo real de los procedimientos. Ese equilibrio solo habría aumentado los beneficios del hospital.

No te equivoques: el capitalismo no perdona.

Si describes el Sacramento de la Reconciliación a alguien que no esté familiarizado con la teología, lo más probable es que piense que Dios es un tonto. "¿Puedes entrar, pedir perdón y marcharte — y todo está bien?" alguien me preguntó una vez con incredulidad.

Bueno, sí. Eso es perdón.

La verdadera misericordia no se puede presupuestar. Debe darse de forma imprudente, extravagante, contra toda razón. Debe costarle al dador. Debe escandalizar a cualquier contador que valga la pena. Y nadie "cumple los requisitos".

Si no consigo entender la idea, puede significar que estoy atrapada en un paradigma de justicia con ánimo de lucro. Puede que solo signifique que necesito recurrir más a la verdadera misericordia. Misericordia que pueda sentir.
