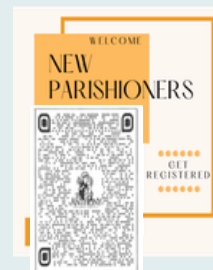

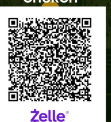

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading:

Seek the Lord while he may be found, call him while he is near. (Is 55:6)

Psalm:

The Lord is near to all who call upon him. (Ps 145)

Gospel:

“What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?” (Mt 20:14-15)

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Matthew 20:1-16a

“Good morning, Lord; You are the first to meet the gaze of my heart as the day begins: You are the light and the sun of my journey. Good morning, Lord; I seek You, lifting my hands and heart to You at the break of dawn: I want to find You always in my brothers and sisters. Good morning, Risen Lord, who brings joy to the heart walking Your paths —Victor over Your death and mine!” (Liturgy of the Hours). As long as we have life, we must seek God until we find Him, always remembering that His designs are not ours and His plans are vastly different from our own (cf. Isaiah 55).

Today's Gospel demonstrates how God loves all His sons and daughters equally. He seeks them out at different times of the day, inviting them to become part of His Kingdom and to live together as brothers and sisters while working in His vineyard. However, the story tells us that when it came time for payment, the workers hired at the beginning of the day complained, expecting to receive more than those hired at the end of the day. The lesson is clear: God is surprising and kind, and He treats everyone equally. Whether we deserve it or not, His love is beyond price or measure. Thank You, God, for Your goodness! What selfish attitudes must I remove from my life to understand God's goodness? Where do I see His mercy in the world, despite the adversities surrounding us? Let us all go to work in the Lord's vineyard; He is waiting for us!

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Why

Sometimes, the Gospel takes everything you think you know about Jesus, throws it in a box, shakes it violently, dumps it on the floor, looks you in the eye and says: “Clean it up.”

And there you are, picking up the pieces, wondering how, after 2,000 years, someone can still keep you guessing.

Today is one of those Gospels. We know Jesus as a champion of the poor. We envision him as a social justice warrior. And now he's advocating for time theft in the workplace? Make it make sense.

Well, at its heart, today's Gospel is a story about who gets what. A story about comparison, which we are told is the thief of joy — but without comparison, nothing would ever get done. In this world, wages are set, court cases are settled, international borders are drawn, all by comparing one entity to another and evaluating that comparison to make a judgment.

What this Gospel doesn't tell us is the “why.” The workers who labored longest in the vineyard feel cheated because those who showed up later earn the same wage. This would be egregious — unless we consider that the only criteria used in the comparison is the length of the work day's duration. Quality and efficiency of work is never even mentioned. For all we know, those all-day workers could have been standing around fanning themselves, and should feel lucky to get what they did.

“Why” is a question we ask a lot in this life. Why did my dad die? Why did I get cancer? Why did my husband lose his job? As we pick up the pieces of today's Gospel, we should ask ourselves this: when we know what we know about Who decides who gets what, do we have to know the “why?”

MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

Mateo 20:1-16a

“Buenos días, Señor, a ti el primero encuentra la mirada del corazón, apenas nace el día: Tú eres la luz y el sol de mi jornada. Buenos días, Señor, a ti te busco, levanto a ti las manos y el corazón, al despertar la aurora: quiero encontrarte siempre en mis hermanos. Buenos días, Señor resucitado, que traes la alegría al corazón que va por tus caminos ¡vencedor de tu muerte y de la mía! (Liturgia de las Horas). Mientras tengamos vida, debemos ir en la búsqueda de Dios hasta encontrarlo, recordando siempre que sus proyectos no son los nuestros y que sus planes son muy distintos a los nuestros (cf. Isaías 55).

El Evangelio de hoy es una muestra de cómo Dios ama a todos sus hijos e hijas por igual. Él los busca a distintas horas del día para que entren a formar parte de su Reino y, al trabajar en su viña, todos convivan como hermanos. Sin embargo, el relato nos dice que, al momento del pago, los trabajadores de la primera hora se quejaron, pues esperaban recibir más que aquellos contratados al final de la jornada. La enseñanza es clara: Dios es desconcertante, bondadoso y trata a todos por igual. Lo merezcamos o no; su amor no tiene precio ni medida. ¡Gracias Dios por tu bondad! ¿Qué actitudes egoístas debo quitar de mi vida para entender la bondad de Dios? ¿Dónde veo su misericordia en el mundo, a pesar de las adversidades que nos rodean? ¡Vamos todos a trabajar en la viña del Señor, Él nos espera!

RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

El Porqué

A veces, el Evangelio toma todo lo que crees saber sobre Jesús, lo mete en una caja, lo sacude violentamente, lo tira al suelo, te mira a los ojos y dice: "Límpialo."

Y ahí estás tú, recogiendo los pedazos, preguntándote cómo, después de 2,000 años, alguien puede seguir manteniéndote en la incertidumbre.

Hoy es uno de esos Evangelios. Conocemos a Jesús como un campeón de los pobres. Lo imaginamos como un guerrero por la justicia social. ¿Y ahora está defendiendo el robo de tiempo en el trabajo? Haz que tenga sentido.

Pues bien, en el fondo, el Evangelio de hoy es una historia sobre quién recibe qué. Una historia sobre la comparación, que nos dicen que es la ladrona de la alegría — pero sin comparación, nada se haría jamás. En este mundo, se fijan los salarios, se resuelven los juicios, se trazan fronteras internacionales, todo comparando una entidad con otra y evaluando esa comparación para emitir un juicio.

Lo que este Evangelio no nos dice es el "por qué". Los trabajadores que más tiempo trabajaron en el viñedo se sienten estafados porque los que llegaron después cobran el mismo salario. Esto sería grave, a menos que consideremos que el único criterio utilizado en la comparación es la duración de la jornada laboral. La calidad y eficiencia del trabajo ni siquiera se mencionan. Hasta donde nosotros sabemos, esos trabajadores de día entero podrían haber estado de pie abanicándose, y deberían sentirse afortunados de haber recibido lo que recibieron.

"¿Por qué?" es una pregunta que nos hacemos mucho en esta vida. ¿Por qué murió mi padre? ¿Por qué me dio cáncer? ¿Por qué mi esposo perdió su trabajo? Al recoger los pedazos del Evangelio de hoy, deberíamos preguntarnos esto: cuando sabemos lo que sabemos sobre quién decide quién recibe qué, ¿tenemos que saber el "por qué"?
