Thu, Sept 25. Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on an overnight flight(s) from San Francisco airport to Lisbon, Portugal. Meals and refreshments are served on the plane.

Fri, Sept 26. Upon landing at Lisbon airport, claim your baggage and proceed to the arrival hall, where your tour guide will greet you. We'll board our bus to take as to our hotel for check-in. **Overnight in Lisbon**.

Sat, Sept 27. Full day tour of Lisbon. Our first stop will be St. Anthony's Church, built upon the site of St. Anthony's birth. The patron saint of lost things is best known as St. Anthony of Padua (Italy), but he was born and baptized here in Lisbon, Portugal. Celebration of the Holy Eucharist. This afternoon we'll enjoy a tour of Lisbon, which will include St. Jerome's Monastery, built to give thanks to the Virgin Mary. We will drive by the Belem Tower and many landmarks, like; the 25th of April Bridge, the Basilica of the Star, and the Marquee of Pombal Square. Dinner and overnight in Lisbon.

Sun, Sept 28. Celebration of the Holy Eucharist this morning at the Capelinha built over the holm oak tree where Our Lady appeared five times to the three shepherd children Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco. We'll tour the basilica and shrine. This afternoon, we'll visit Aljustrel where the angel of Portugal appeared, and Valinhos where Our Lady appeared in August of 1917. Tonight, we'll participate in the rosary and candlelight procession. **Dinner and overnight in Fatima**.

Mon, Sept 29. This morning we'll take a short drive to the city of Coimbra. Upon arrival we'll celebrate the Holy Eucharist at the Carmel of Santa Teresa. Visit the Church and Monastery of Santa Cruz, where saint Anthony lived for 15 years, completing his Theology studies and was ordained a priest from the order of the Canons of Saint Augustine. We'll drive back to Fatima and participate in the rosary and candlelight procession. **Dinner and overnight in Fatima**.

Tue, Sept 30. Morning drive to Lisbon airport for a short flight to Rome, Italy. Upon arrival in Rome, we'll meet our guide at the airport arrival hall, and we'll board our bus to take us to our hotel for check-in. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

Wed, Oct 1. After breakfast at the hotel, we'll head to St. Peter's Square for the Papal Audience at 9 a.m., led by His Holiness, Pope Francis (subject to his schedule). After lunch, we will tour the Vatican Museum, exploring the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel. Our day ends at St. Peter's Basilica, where we view Michelangelo's Pieta and the tomb of St. Pope John Paul II, and walk through the basilica, finishing at the Tomb of St. Peter. Today we will also walk through the Holy Door of St. Peters, which symbolizes passing into the presence of God by way of our Lord Jesus, who called himself the "gate." Those who pass through a Holy Door can also receive a plenary indulgence. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

Thu, Oct 2. Today is dedicated to the Major Basilicas. We will start at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls and visit the burial site of St. Paul. Next, we're off to the Church of St. Mary Major where pilgrims can view what is said to be the wood relics of the Holy Crib of the Nativity of Jesus. Visit the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the "Mother of all Churches in the World," and the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. Free time for lunch and afternoon walking tour of the Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain and Colosseum, (Outside) a grand amphitheatre of the ancient world, passing by the Via del Forum Imperiale, we will witness the ruins of ancient government. **Dinner and overnight in Rome.**

Fri, Oct 3. After breakfast we'll drive north to the picturesque town of Assisi. Leisure time for lunch. Afternoon guided tour of the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi and the Basilica of Saint Clare to see the Saint's body and pray for her intercession in front of the San Damiano Cross. St. Clare was the foundress of the Order of Poor Clare's. We will also visit the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis in Santa Maria Maggiore church. Celebration of the Holy Eucharist. We'll end our day with a visit to the Basilica di Santa Maria Dagli Angeli. This basilica is divided into two sections: the "Porziuncola," where St. Francis received his calling and embraced a life of poverty, and the "Capella del Transito," the small room where he peacefully passed away. Dinner and overnight in Perugia.

Sat, Oct 4. Following breakfast, we'll board the motorcoach for a transfer to Padua. This Northern Italian city honors the "Patron Saint of Lost Things and Causes", St. Anthony. The tour will include the Basilica of St. Anthony, where you will have the opportunity to visit his tomb. Check-in at the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Venice.

Sun, Oct 5. Our day begins with a Holy Eucharist in Basilica of St. Anthony. We will continue for sightseeing tour of Padua, including a view of one of the oldest Universities in Italy, the University of Padua, as well as the Basilica of Santa Giustina, the "Patron Saint of Padua". Visit the Capella Degli Scrovegni, painted by Giotto, considered the jewel and masterpiece of the city. Afternoon free time. **Dinner and overnight in Venice.**

Mon, Oct 6. Today after breakfast we'll board our bus to depart for the magical city of Venice. Your walking tour includes a visit to St. Mark's Square, the largest square in the city and the site of many government buildings; the Golden Basilica of San Marco, known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testament of the Bible; the Bridge of Sigh, a bridge that will bring eternal love to those who drift below it. You will also have the chance to view the Doges' Palace (outside), which served as the seat of the Government for the Republic of Venice for centuries. **Dinner and overnight in Venice**.

Tue, Oct 7. Today we bid farewell to Italy, boarding our flight home.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the trip.

Pricing: Canterbury Pigrimages, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions).
